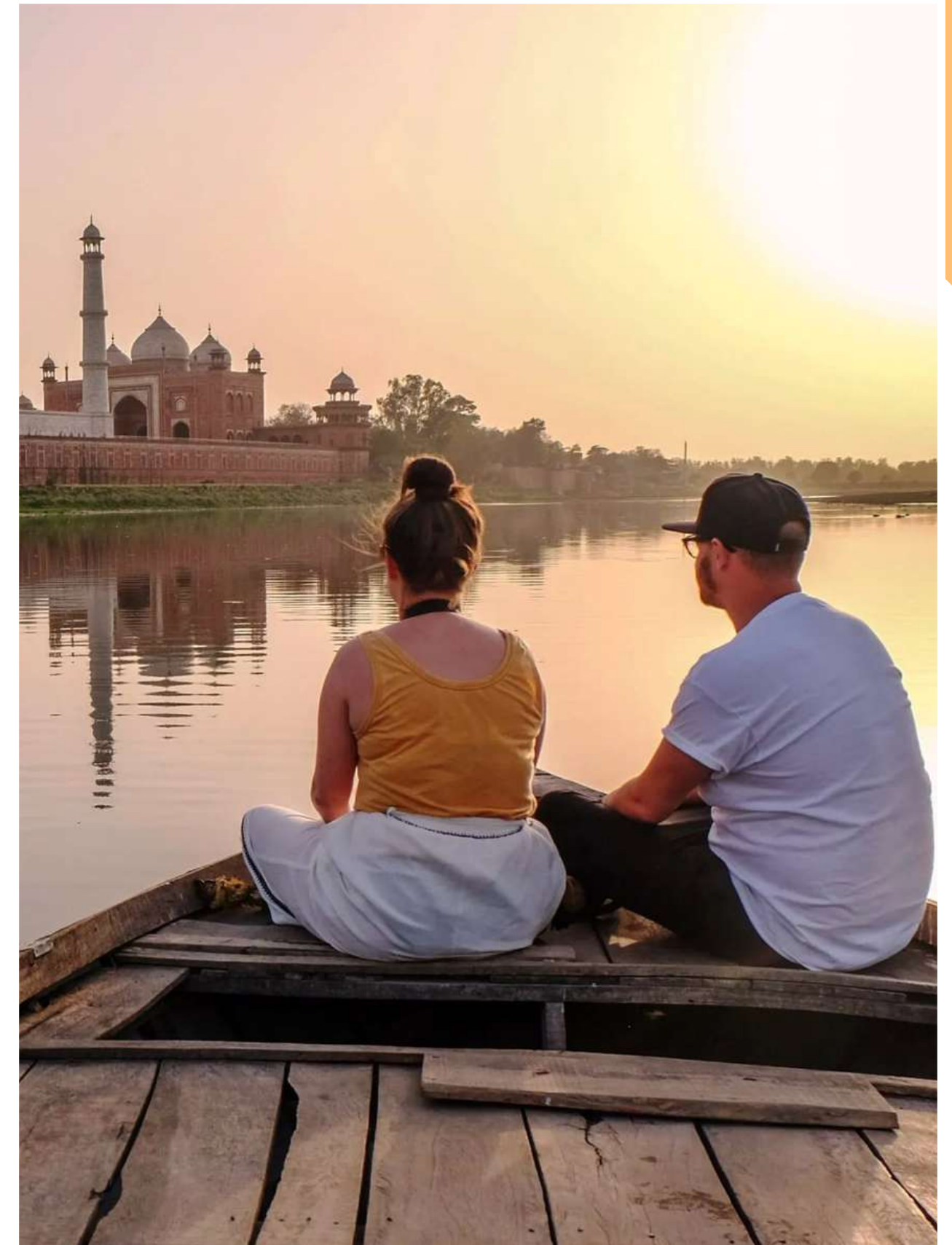

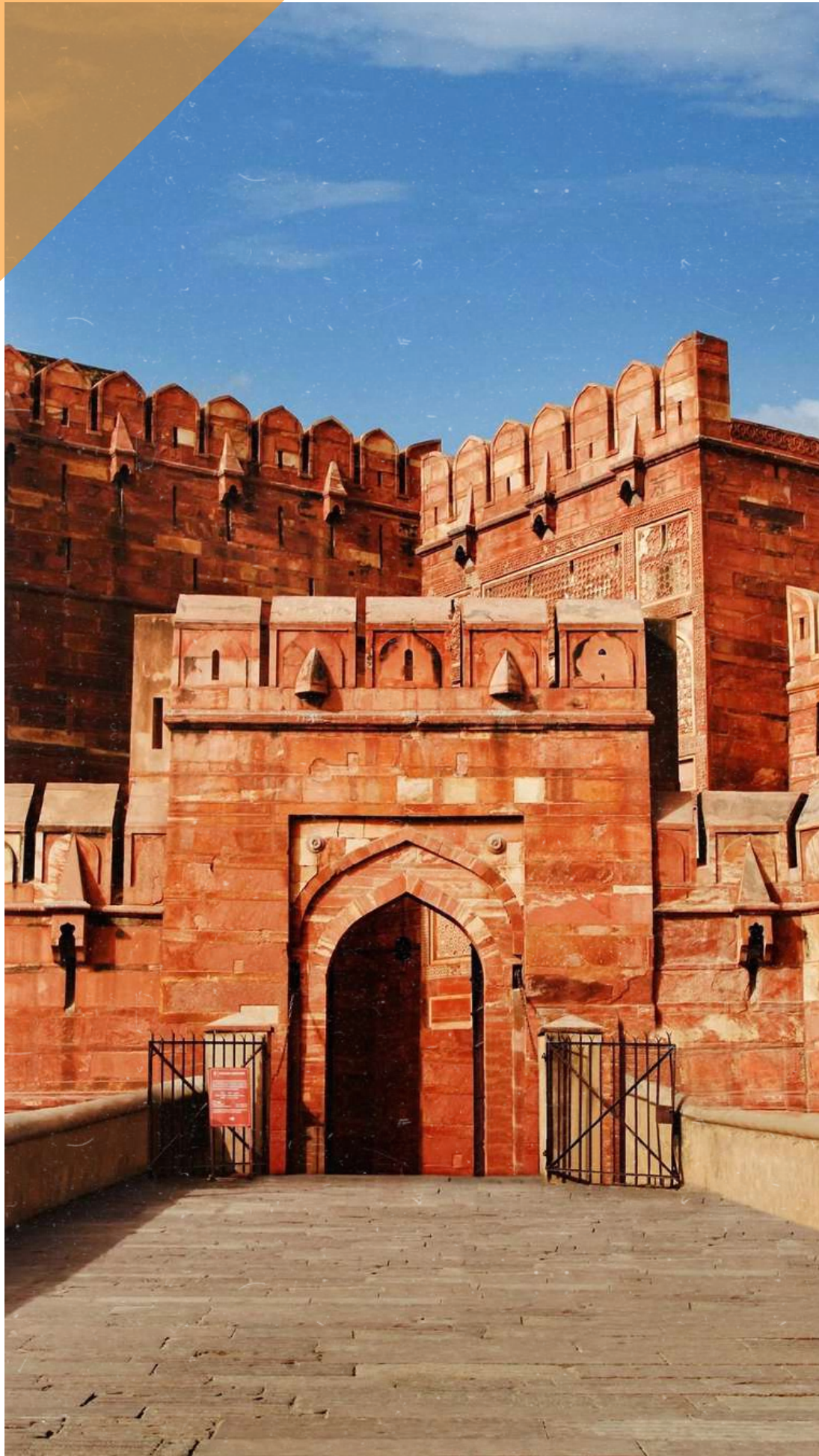

Tomb of Akbar

One of the most significant examples of Mughal architecture is the tomb of Akbar the Great, which can be seen at Sikandra, a suburb of Agra. It was constructed between 1605 and 1613. According to Tartarian tradition, which mandated starting the construction of one's tomb during one's lifetime, Akbar himself started building this tomb.

Keoladeo Ghana National Park

It is acknowledged as one of the most significant bird breeding and feeding grounds in the world. The British and Maharajas used it as a game reserve when it first began as a royal hunting preserve in the 1850s. In 1985 UNESCO added it to its list of World Heritage Sites. More than 370 different bird and animal species, including the basking python, painted storks, deer, nilgai, and others, may be found in the park.
