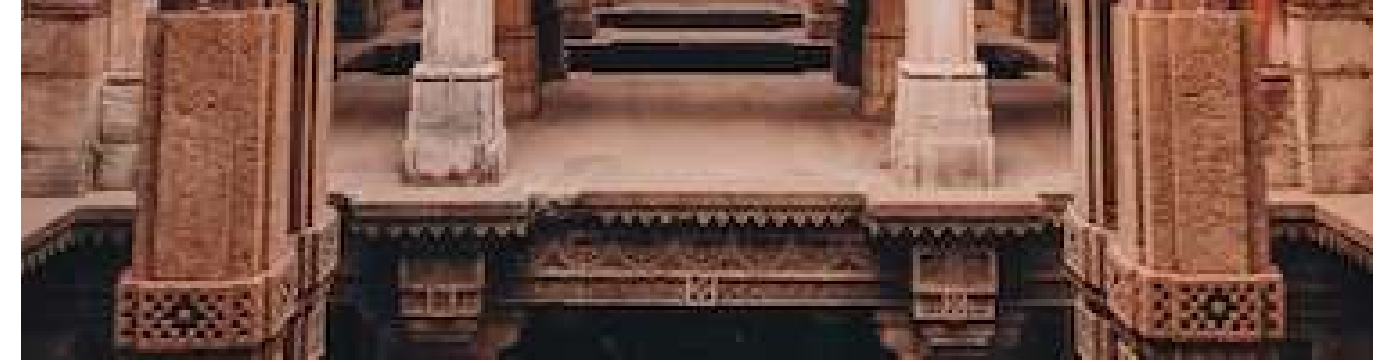




Amritsar

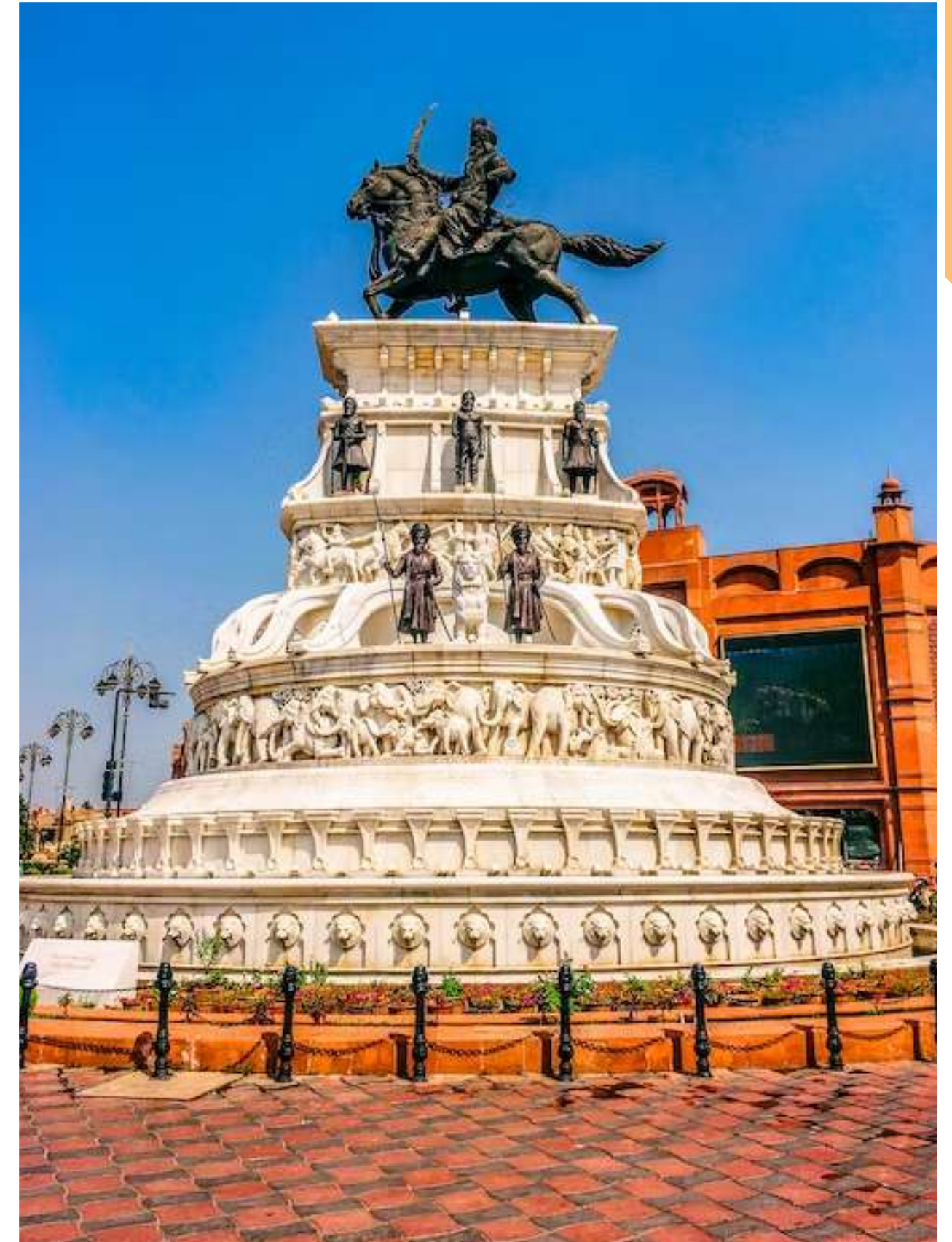

Explore Amritsar

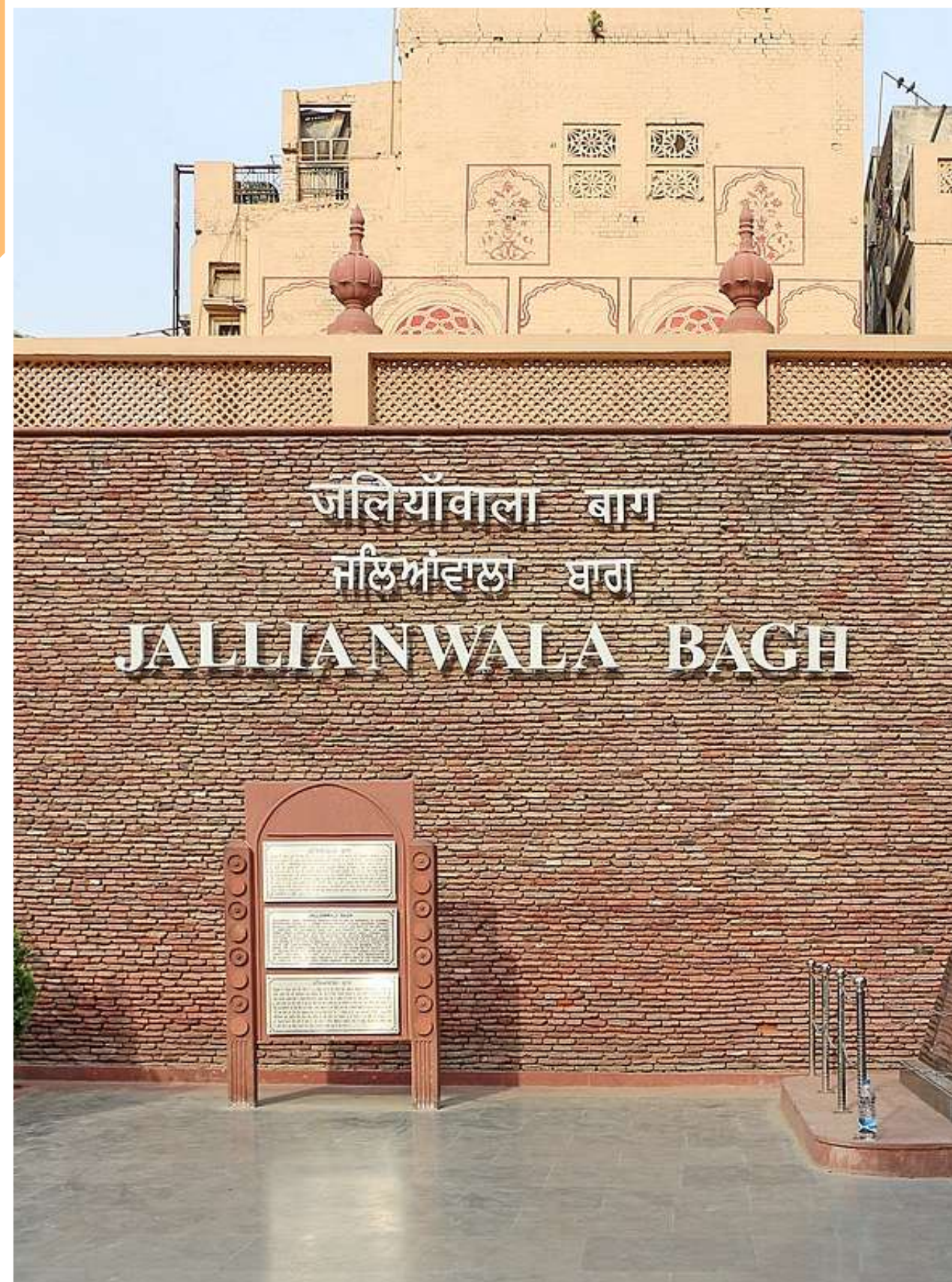
- Amritsar, the capital and largest city of Punjab, is a well-known hub for commerce, culture, and transportation.

The Golden Temple

The Golden Temple is a Gurdwara in the city of Amritsar, Punjab, India. It is also known as Harmandir Sahib, which means "abode of God," or Darbr Sahib, which means "exalted court." It is the most revered Gurdwara and significant place of pilgrimage in Sikh religion. The gurudwara complex was rebuilt following the violence of 1984 between Sikh organisations and the Indian government. All devotees are welcome to visit the Golden Temple for free and receive a free darshan. Without visiting this sacred site, an Amritsar vacation would be incomplete.



Jallianwala Bagh

One of the most horrific massacres in human history took place at Jallianwala Bagh, a tragic incident that occurred during the war for Indian freedom. Up to 1100 nonviolent protestors were massacred when British troops opened fire here on April 13, 1919, a tragedy also known as the Amritsar Massacre. The barbaric killing of thousands fueled the resistance movement against the British and cast serious doubt on their aspirations to rule India in a civilised manner. The park is now a tribute to those who gave their lives in battle.



Wagah Border

India and Pakistan are separated by the Wagah Border. There is a flag ceremony done here every evening after sunset, after which the gates are shut for the day. The retreat ritual is equally as captivating as a drama on stage. Soldiers ceremoniously lower the flag as they march in unison. Thousands of people wait in line to witness the event at Wagah Border Attari. It serves as both a display of pride in one's country and amusement for everybody.

Durgiana Temple

Located in the city of Amritsar, the Durgiana Temple is also known as the Lakshmi Narayan Temple, Durga Tirath, and Sitla Mandir. Its architecture is comparable to the Golden Temple even though it is a Hindu temple. The primary goddess venerated and deified here, Durga, is where this temple gets her name. In the courtyard of the shrine, there is a special statue of Lord Hanuman taking a nap. It is renowned for its collection of Hindu scriptures as well.

Baba Atal Tower

A well-known Gurdwara in Amritsar is Gurdwara Baba Atal. One of Amritsar's best architectural wonders and one of the Sikh religion's most emotive places of devotion is just a short walk from the iconic Harmandir Sahib, which is visited by millions of pilgrims each year. The tower was constructed from 1778 to 1784. The Gurdwara Baba Atal Sahib, a stunning nine-story Gurudwara Sahib, presently stands on the site.

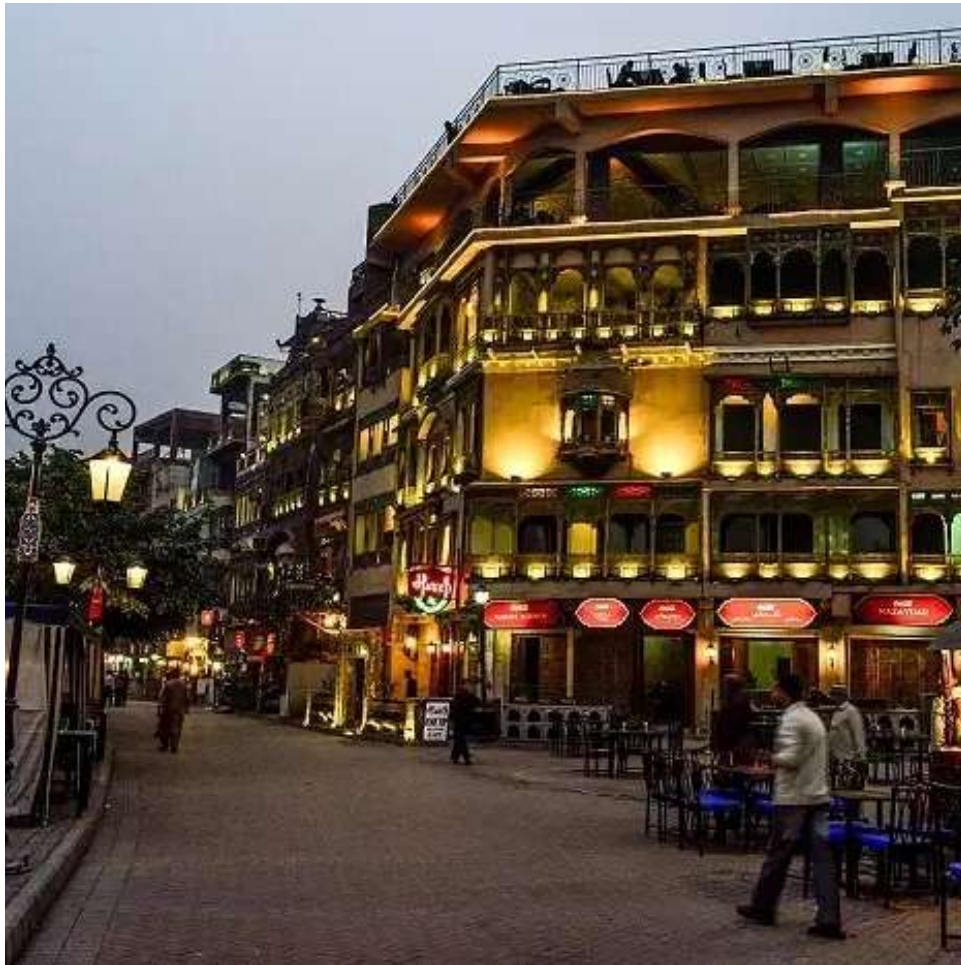
