


Explore The Islands



Ross Island

Ross Island (formerly known as Netaji Subhash Bose Island), which was originally the British government's administrative center but is now just a deserted island, is located just 2 kms East of Port Blair. Today, everything is gone but for a few structures that once held some of these landmarks. Some historic structures, including the neighborhood shops and bakery, have been successfully rebuilt by the Indian Navy to give visitors a sense of the past. These shops also provide souvenirs for sale.



North Bay Island

North Bay is a small, isolated island close to Port Blair that is frequently visited by travelers taking a day trip to. It is among the top locations in the Andaman Islands for water sports. 
