



Arunachal Pradesh








Namdapha National Park






Sela Pass

The Sela Pass mountain pass in Arunachal Pradesh, which is situated at a height of 13,700 feet above sea level, is one of the most serene places to visit. Sela Pass, which is reported to be encircled by a total of 101 lakes, is highly revered by Buddhists. The most picturesque and gorgeous blue Sela Lake serves as the primary magnet for tourists to Arunachal Pradesh.





Roing

Roing means cool and rejuvenating. True to its name, this town is situated next to the Dibang River, which enhances the beauty and tranquilly of the area as it passes by. 




Dirang


Ziro Valley

Wide paddy rice fields, attractive bamboo huts, tranquil hamlets, and a variety of unusual vegetation cover the floors of the village of Ziro Valley.






Day 01: Arrival Guwahati - Nameri

- Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dirang




Day 03: Dirang

- Dinner and overnight at hotel in Dirang








Day 04: Dirang - Tawang

Day 05: Tawang

- Proceed for full day sightseeing of Tawang which includes Tawang Monastery, the second largest Buddhist monastery in India, and the birthplace of the 6th Dalai Lama. The monastery is the house of more than 700 monks.
- Later visit Urgelling Monastery

- Later visit crafts center & Tawang War Memorial
- Return to hotel
- Dinner and overnight in Tawang








Day 06: Tawang - Bomdila

 Centre
- Bomdila also provides a bird's eye perspective of the state's tallest peaks, Kangto and Gorichen, set against the backdrop of the Himalayas and snow-covered mountains.
- Proceed to hotel

- Overnight in Bomdila hotel


