


Assam State Zoo



Guwahti Planetrium

The Guwahati Planetarium is a well-known astronomical research facility. Kakochang Waterfall

Umananda Temple

Umananda Temple in Guwahati, where Lord Shiva is the primary deity, is a tranquil retreat for those who love the outdoors. King Gadadhar Singh constructed the Umananda Temple in 1694 AD. It is perched atop the peak Bhasmakuta and is encircled by the River Brahmaputra's gushing waters.







Kaziranga National Park

Two-thirds of the one-horned rhinoceros on the earth live at the Kaziranga National Park. What keeps this location at the top of the list of tourist destinations in Assam is its dynamic, well-preserved, sustained nature, and a diverse wildlife. The national park is a must visit attraction of Assam.

Majuli Island

Majuli is one of the major tourist destinations in Assam because of its breathtaking natural scenery. It is both the largest riverine island in the world. The islands cover a total area of 452 sq km, and the majority of them are buried in water during the monsoon season.


