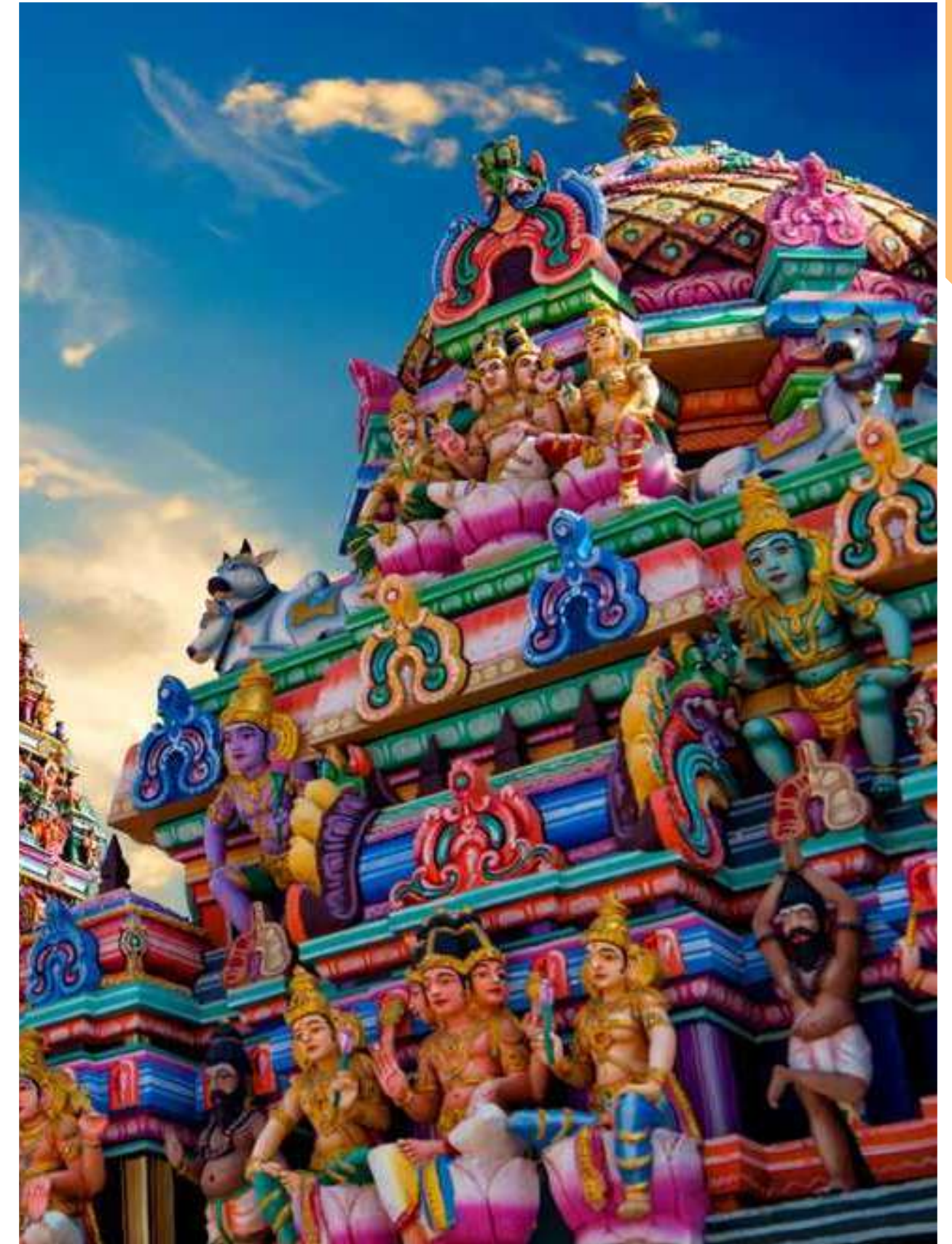

The Marina Beach

Madras University, government offices, Senate House, Presidency College, the cricket stadium, Swami Vivekananda Memorial House, and All India Radio are all located on the side of the street that faces the seaside.

Government Museum

The second-oldest museum in the nation, after the Indian Museum in Kolkata is the Government Museum, which was founded in 1851. It is located in the Chennai neighbourhood of Egmore and was constructed in the Indo-Sarcenic style. It contains a substantial collection of Raja Ravi Varma's works. The Madras Museum promises to entice everyone as a rich collection of the best works of art, archaeology, anthropology, numismatics, and much more.

Guindy National Park

The eighth-smallest national park in India, Guindy National Park is a 2.70 km² protected area of Tamil Nadu in Chennai, India. It is one of the very few national parks to be located inside a metropolis. 400 blackbucks, 2,000 spotted deers, 24 jackals, several snakes, geckos, tortoises, over 130 species of birds, 14 species of animals, over 60 species of butterflies, and spiders are all found in the park, which plays a part in both ex-situ and in-situ conservation.

Valluvar Kottam

Valluvar Kottam is a historical landmark in Chennai, which honours the revered intellectual poet, philosopher, and saint Thiruvalluvar, who wrote the well-known Thirukkural more than 2,000 years ago. Thirukkural contains 1330 verses total, spread across its 133 chapters. It was constructed between 1975 and 1976 by M. Karunanidhi, Tamil Nadu's then-chief minister. The best approach to honour him and his enormous body of outstanding achievements was through the creation of Valluvar Kottam.

Fort St. George

Visit Fort St. George to travel back in time and learn more about British colonial history. Fort St. George, a well-known landmark in Chennai, is a location where you can appreciate the exhibitions of British Raj antiques and learn more about the high level of living enjoyed by British emperors. The Fort St. George, also known as the White House, is one of India's oldest structures and is home to the renowned St. Mary's Church and Fort Museum.

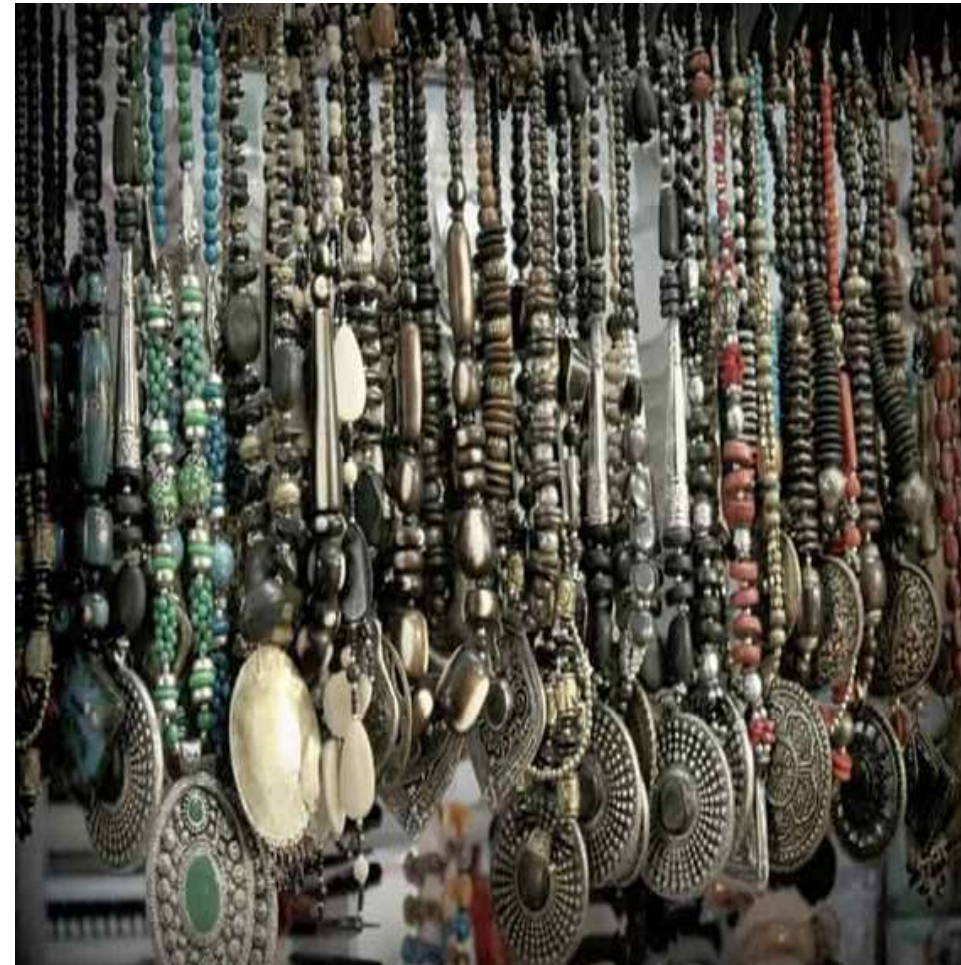

Mahabalipuram

In the southern Indian state of Tamil Nadu, about 60 kilometres from Chennai, is the temple city of Mahabalipuram (also known as Mamallapuram). Through a network of roadways, the city is easily accessible from Chennai and other significant South Indian towns. Nearly 33,000 towering temples and magnificent monuments with Dravidian-era sculptures, rich inscriptions, and sophisticated architectural designs can be found in the state of Tamil Nadu. It is home to some of the world's most remarkable architectural marvels.





Shore Temple

One of India's most beloved and venerated temples, this one is particularly stunning because it is situated beside the Bay of Bengal. This magnificent structure of the Indian subcontinent, which dates back to the seventh century, exhibits a strong Pallava influence.



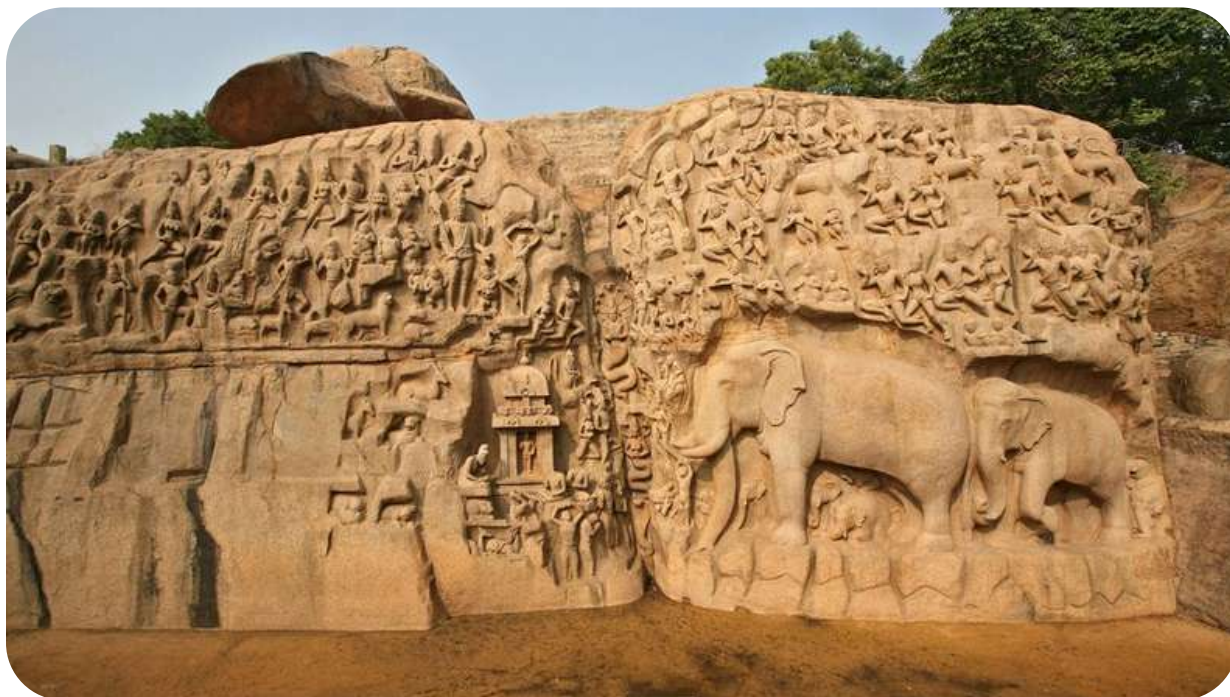
Vedagrishvara Temple

Due to a miracle that occurs here every day, Vedagrishvara Temple is highly recommended. Two eagles visit the Vedagrishvara Temple every day, and they do it at a set time. This fortunate occurrence has given the temple a unique place among the temples of South India.



Sea Shell Musuem

The Sea Shell Museum is one of Mahabalipuram's newest attractions and the biggest museum of its sort in Asia. The museum has a collection of 40k specimens of rare and distinctive shells, serving as both a repository for many kinds of shells and an educational resource for visitors.



Arjuna's Penance

This wonder of rock art is situated in Mamallapuram, 58 kms from Chennai. One of the largest open-air rock sculptures in the world, measuring over 96 feet long and 43 feet high and carved on the faces of two massive neighbouring boulders in the middle of the seventh century.
