- At an elevation of 6,700 feet, Darjeeling is a city and a municipality in the Indian state of West Bengal.
- It is well known for both its tea business and views of Kangchenjunga, the third-highest mountain in the world.
- UNESCO has designated the Darjeeling Himalayan Railway as a World Heritage Site.
- Darjeeling rarely receives snowfall. It only snows in the months of December, January, and February
- The highest grade of tea is produced and exported from Darjeeling; it is processed to make black, green, white, and oolong tea.

The first tea gardens were established in Darjeeling in 1852, when it was still a little hamlet and the British officers and their families. Some of the finest tea farms in the world are reputed to be located in Darjeeling. Acres of beautiful meadows at the UNESCO World Heritage Site make for the ideal tourist destination. Himalayan Mountaineering Institute

One of the top mountaineering institutes in the world is the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (HMI). Founded on November 4th, 1954, to honour the first successful ascent of Mount Everest by late Tenzing Norgay Sherpa and Sir Edmund Hillary by none other than Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India.

Itinerary

Day 03

- Breakfast at hotel
- After breakfast excursion trip to Mirik Lake, nestled in forested hills at an altitude of 5800 ft (2 hr 30 min)
- It is famous for its man-made Sumendu Lake - orange orchards, cardamom plantations and tea estates enhance the surroundings here.
- Lunch at Indian Restaurant in Mirik
- Evening return to the hotel
- Dinner at hotel and overnight in Darjeeling



Tibetan Refuge

A rehabilitation facility for Tibetan refugees in the Darjeeling Himalayan hill region is the Tibetan Refugee Self Help Center in Darjeeling, India. It was founded on October 2, 1959, when they fled Tibet in pursuit of the Dalai Lama.

The primary activity of the centre is the manufacturing of Tibetan handicrafts.
