


Explore Gangtok


- The capital and largest town in the state of Sikkim is Gangtok, a city municipality.

Coronation Bridge

The stunning city of Siliguri, which is a part of the Darjeeling and Jalpaiguri Districts in the wonderful north-eastern Indian state of West Bengal, is where Coronation Bridge is situated. Because of the accessibility it offers, the bridge, which carries National Highway 31, is also known as the lifeline between Kalimpong, Nathula, and Gangtok.

Visitors who want to experience its majesty and get a panoramic view of the River Teesta flowing beneath it frequently visit this bridge, which is a magnificent example of Roman-inspired architecture.





- Dinner & overnight stay at Hotel






Tsomgo Lake

About 40 kilometres (25 miles) from the state capital Gangtok, in the East Sikkim region of the Indian state of Sikkim, is a glacier lake known as Tsomgo Lake. The lake, which is 3,753 metres (12,313 feet) above sea level, is frozen throughout the year. The indigenous Sikkimese people have a tremendous respect for the lake's surface, which changes colour with the seasons. In the middle of May, as the winter season ends, the lake's edge bursts with beautiful varities of flowers. Numerous bird species, notably Brahminy ducks, can also be observed in the lake's vicinity. Red Pandas are also seen here.





Nathula Pass

Nathu La is a mountain pass in the Himalayan ranges that connects Sikkim with China. It is one of the world's highest motorable roads. Nathu La, one of the most significant Himalayan passes in the nation, is located on the Indo-Tibetan border at a height of 14,450 feet. Nathu and La both refer to listening ears and passing. One of the three open trading border crossings between India and China, Nathu La is well known for its stunning beauty and lovely surroundings. Most of this place is still rather cool. Visitors have to get a permit.

- Post lunch, visit to Rumtek Monastry the abode of the third highest Buddhist Monk in the Tibetan Buddhist sect, Karmapa Lama.
- Evening Ropeway Ride, Tashi View Point (time permitting)
- Dinner and overnight at hotel








Namgyal Institute of Tibetology.

The Namgyal Institute of Tibetology was founded in 1958, and since then it has financed and encouraged studies on the Sikkimese people's religion, history, language, art, and culture. The NIT library houses a museum of Tibetan iconography and religious art in addition to one of the greatest collections of Tibetan works outside of Tibet. Since 1964, it has released a number of books as well as the Bulletin of Tibetology.





Rumtek Monastry

The monastery, which is around 23 kilometres from Gangtok, was constructed by the ninth Karmapa under the direction of Sikkim's fourth King. The Karmapa Lama, the third-highest monk in Tibetan Buddhism, resides in Rumtek Monastery, the largest monastery in Sikkim. It is also known as the Dharmachakra Center and is one of the most significant locations outside of Tibet for the Kagyu (Black Hat) school of Tibetan Buddhism.
