


Hampi






Explore Hampi

- Hampi is a popular destination for those interested in bouldering and rock climbing.






Chithradurga Fort

On the Vedavati River's banks stands the Chitradurga Fort. It is a sizable fort situated on a collection of granite hills that spans 1500 acres. Chitradurga Fort is renowned as the land of valor and chivalry since it was constructed over the course of eight centuries in various stages. Locals refer to it as Kallina Kote (the stone fort), and people are transported back to India's glorious past by its magnificence and glory. Chitradurga Fort, one of the top tourist destinations in Karnataka, is a thrilling weekend getaway that is only 200 kilometers from Bengaluru.






Mantaga Hill

One of the top destinations in Hampi to visit is Mantaga Hill. The greatest location to gain a bird'seye perspective of Hampi and its surroundings is atop a hilltop that is likely the highest point in Hampi. The Koodanda Rama Temple is situated on the banks of the Tungabhadra River, to the north of the hill. Achyuta Raya Temple's boundary is the hill's eastern side. The northern portion of the hill is ideal for hikers and connects the Achyuta Raya Temple on the opposite side of the hill to the Hampi Bazaar.





Virupaksha Temple

On the banks of the Tungabhadra river in Hampi stands the Virupaksha temple. The temple was built in the 7th century, and because of its stunning architecture and fascinating past, it has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage site. The temple is home to Lord Virupaksha, one of Lord Shiva's incarnations. It was formerly a tiny shrine located in the heart of the illustrious and venerable Vijayanagara empire. The temple's long history is attested to by lovely stone inscriptions from the 7th century that may be found on its walls.






Lakshmi Temple

The largest statue of Narasimha seated atop SeshaNaag, the seven-headed serpent that serves as a refuge to him, can be found in this temple. Alongside Narasimha's idol is one of the goddess Lakshmi. The statue itself was constructed in 1528 AD and was established during the time of the Vijayanagara ruler Krishnadevaraya. It is regarded as the largest monolith statue in Hampi. The statue was damaged when the Mughals raided Hampi, and it is now kept at the Archaeological Museum in Kamalapura.





Daroji Bear Sanctuary

Sloth Bears now live in this sanctuary, which was transformed from a thorny woodland to a beautiful green region in 1994. The only place to observe sloth bears in captivity is in the Daroji Bear Sanctuary. Sloth bears are native to India. The 80 sq. km. bear sanctuary, which is close to Bellary in the Sandur Taluk, is crucial to the survival of these bears. There are about 120 sloth bears in this area, along with many other animal species like jackals, leopards, and wild boars.





Hazara Rama Temple

In Hampi, there is a temple honoring Lord Rama called Hazara Rama Temple. Travelers from all over the world come to the temple for its spectacular vista and its beautiful sculptures. The many avatars depicted in numerous inscriptions and are sculptures found throughout the temple. The dazzling structure's elaborate carvings of Gods and Goddesses serve as evidence of India's religious and cultural importance. In the middle of the royal territory stands the Hazara Rama Temple, which was built in the fifteenth century. In Karnataka, it is one of the most popular spots for photography.
