


# Jammu & Kashmir

- Srinagar is also know as "Venice of the East."








### Dal Lake

The most visited destination in Srinagar is Dal Lake, which is regarded as the tourism crown jewel of Kashmir. This must-see location is perfect for families, couples, and even solo travellers looking for peace and quiet because it is surrounded by the magnificent Pir Panjal mountains and Mughal Gardens. Dal Lake also welcomes anglers with its abundance of fish, including Carp. The floating flower and vegetable market is also a must-see location.






### Shalimar Bagh

The Shalimar Bagh, one of the most well-known tourist destinations in Srinagar, is situated on the shores of the pristine Dal Lake and is the largest Mughal Garden in the Kashmir valley. This garden, which is 31 acres in size, used to be Emperor Jahangir and his court's go-to summer resort. The original name of this stunning work of art, "Farah Baksh," which means "delightful" in Arabic, was the "home of love."





### Hazratbal Mosque

Prophet Mohammed's hair is kept in Hazratbal, which is regarded as the most sacred site in Kashmir. The Moi-e-Muqaddas or "the relic" are other names for the hair. Combining the words Hazrat and Bal, which both imply holy or respected, creates the phrase "holy place" or "respected place." Hazratbal Shrine is a significant tourist attraction in Srinagar, and Muslims around the nation make it a point to pay a visit here at least once in their lifetime.






### Tulip Garden

The largest park in Asia to date, the 30-hectare Tulip Garden is located near Srinagar. This garden, which is situated in the Zabarwan Range's slopes, also provides a glimpse of the well-known Dal Lake. It was launched in 2007 with the express purpose of boosting Kashmir Valley tourism. The garden is laid out in a terrace-style with seven terraces. Other varieties of flowers, including hyacinth, ranunculus, daffodils, and many others, are also available to visitors.






# Shankaracharya Temple

One of Srinagar's biggest religious destinations is the Shankarcharya Temple, which is devoted to Lord Shiva. It bears the name of Shankarcharya, a famous philosopher who once travelled to Kashmir. The Hindu temple is ideally situated so that visitors and worshippers can get a wide-angle view of Srinagar City. The 243-step staircase leading to the temple, also known as Jyeshteshwara Temple, is used by the many Hindu pilgrims who come during the Amarnath Yatra season.









