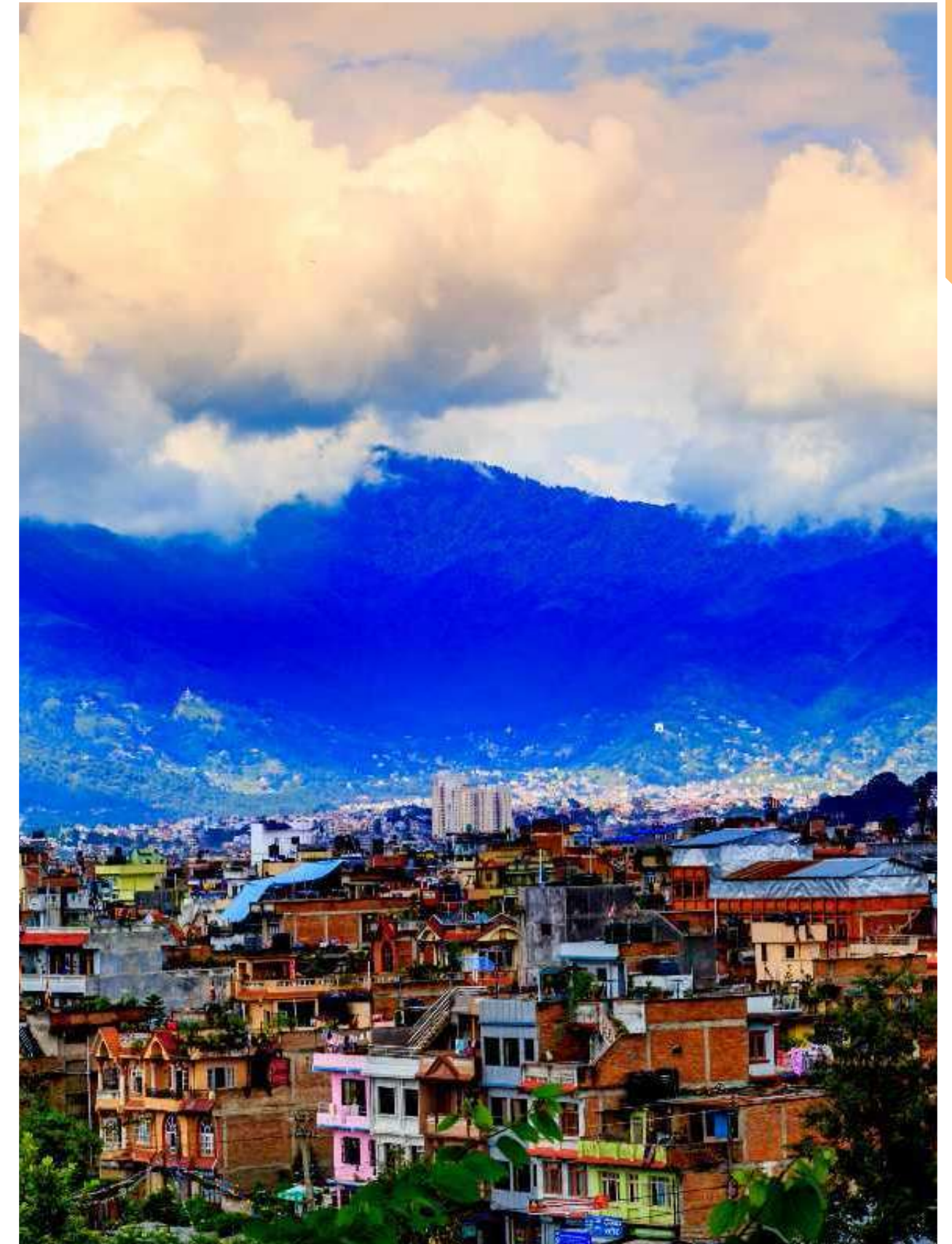

Climate



- Spring (March to May) Numerous visitors and one of the greatest times to travel
- Summer (June-August) 28 degrees Celsius on average, however temperatures are substantially higher in hilly locations.
- Rainy Season (June to September) Rainfall of 2,500 millimetres annually results in a lush, green environment.
- Autumn (September to November) The beautiful weather is largely unaffected by the cold
- Winter (December through February) Nearly freezing temperatures and heavy snowfall are experienced in steep areas.
- The best seasons to visit the nation are in the spring and fall.



Durbar Square

The location where successive kings have sat and governed over Nepal for a very long time, as well as where new kings have been crowned to the continuous pounding of drums and trumpets. One of the three durbar squares in the nation is the opulent Kathmandu Durbar Square. The location continues to be Kathmandu's traditional architecture's most impressive heritage.



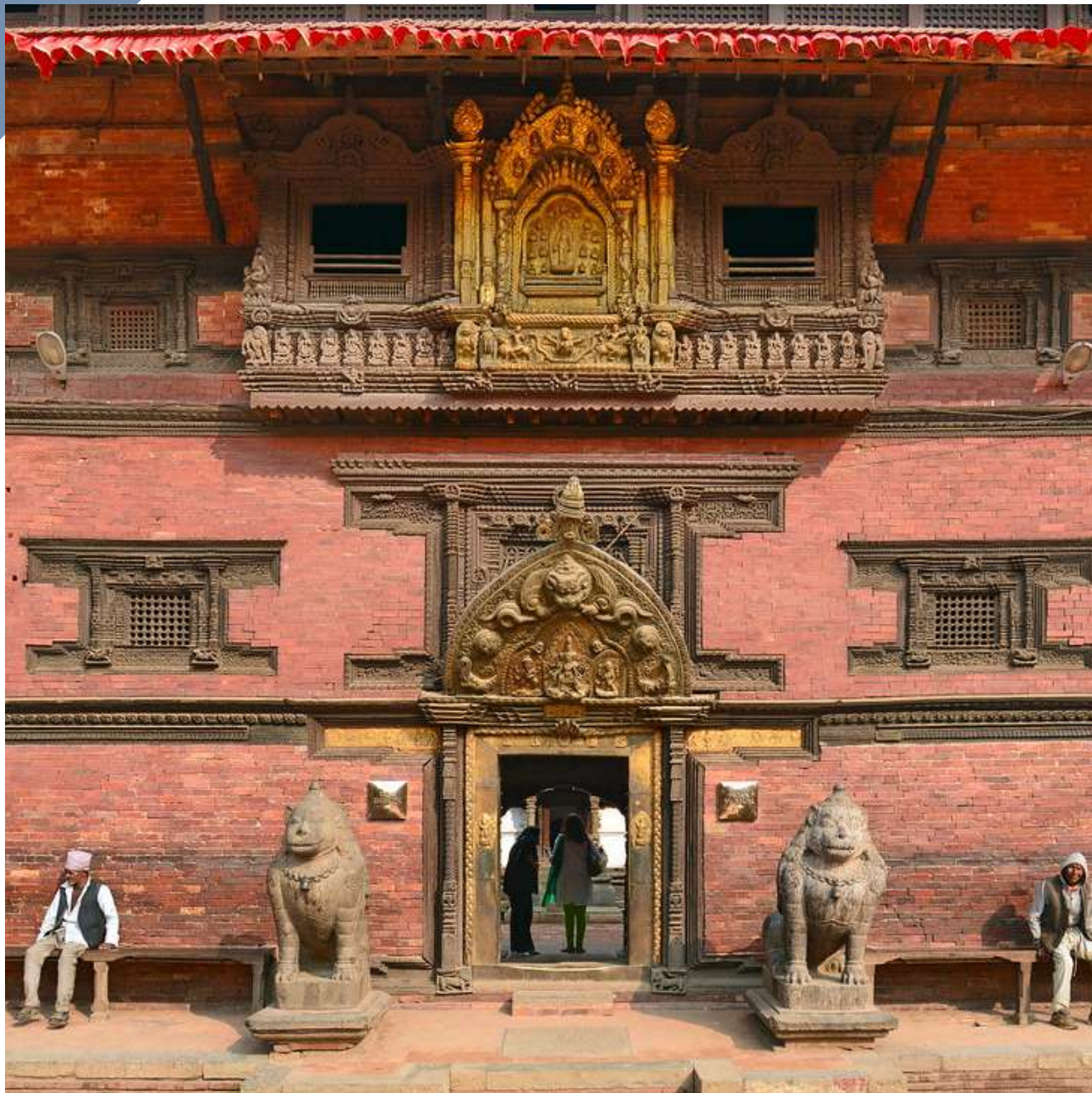
Garden Of Dreams

The Garden of Dreams in Kathmandu is a neo-classical garden created by Kishore Narshingh in 1920. It is also known as the "Swapna Bageecha" and the "Garden of Six Seasons." The garden attracts both locals and visitors with its beautiful amphitheatre, urns, lovely pavilions, paved perimeter walkways, pergolas, and ponds.



Hiranya Varna Mahavihar

In Patan, Lalitpur District, Nepal, there is an ancient vihara called Hiranyavarna Mahavihar. It is a Buddhist shrine called the Golden Temple in the area, and rats are fed there. King Bhaskar Verma constructed this three-story golden pagoda of Lokeshwor (Lord Buddha) in the twelfth century. The golden statue of Lord Buddha and a sizable prayer wheel are located inside the pagoda's upper story.



Patan Museum

The Patan Museum is located in a courtyard inside the Durbar area's northernmost building complex. People today refer to the most gorgeous area of the palace, which piety and pride have carved out of such a small space, as Keshav Narayan Chowk, named for the temple devoted to Lord Vishnu's incarnation Keshavnarayan that stands in the courtyard's centre.



Budhanilkantha Temple

On the outskirts of Kathmandu, close to the Shivpuri Hills' foothills, is where you'll find the Budhanilkanta Temple. Nepal is a treasure trove that is overflowing with historical, natural, and cultural assets. The Budhanilkantha temple, also known as the temple of the sleeping Narayan, is a lesser-known jewel located within the Kathmandu valley, alongside these and other well-known Nepalese attractions.

One of the main draws to Nepal is adventure tourism. With activities for both nature lovers and thrill seekers, this place is perfect for busy tourists. In addition to the traditional activities of hiking, mountaineering, and game viewing, tourists can also partake in activities like rafting, bicycling, fishing, hot air ballooning, and even bungee jumping.

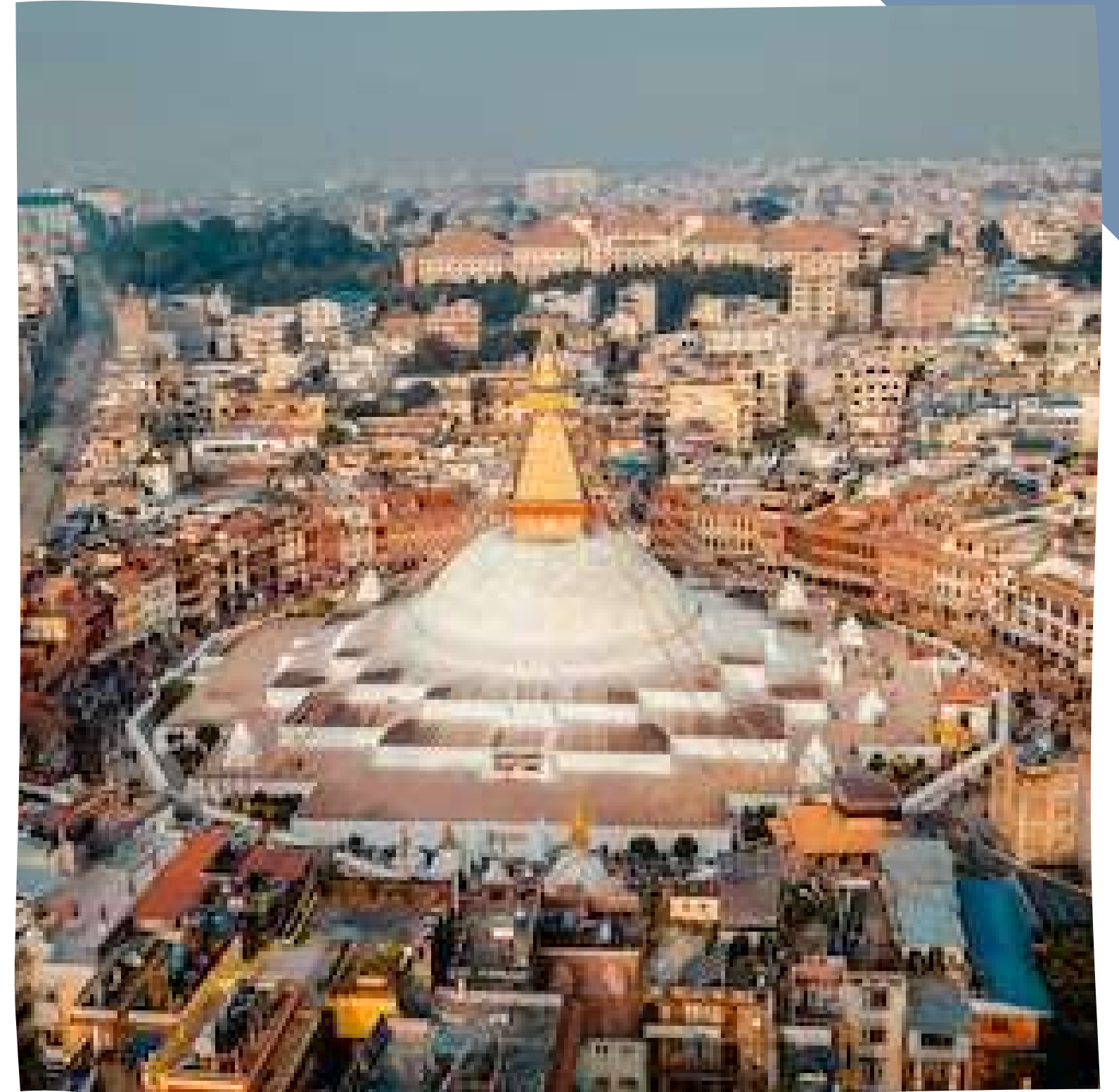

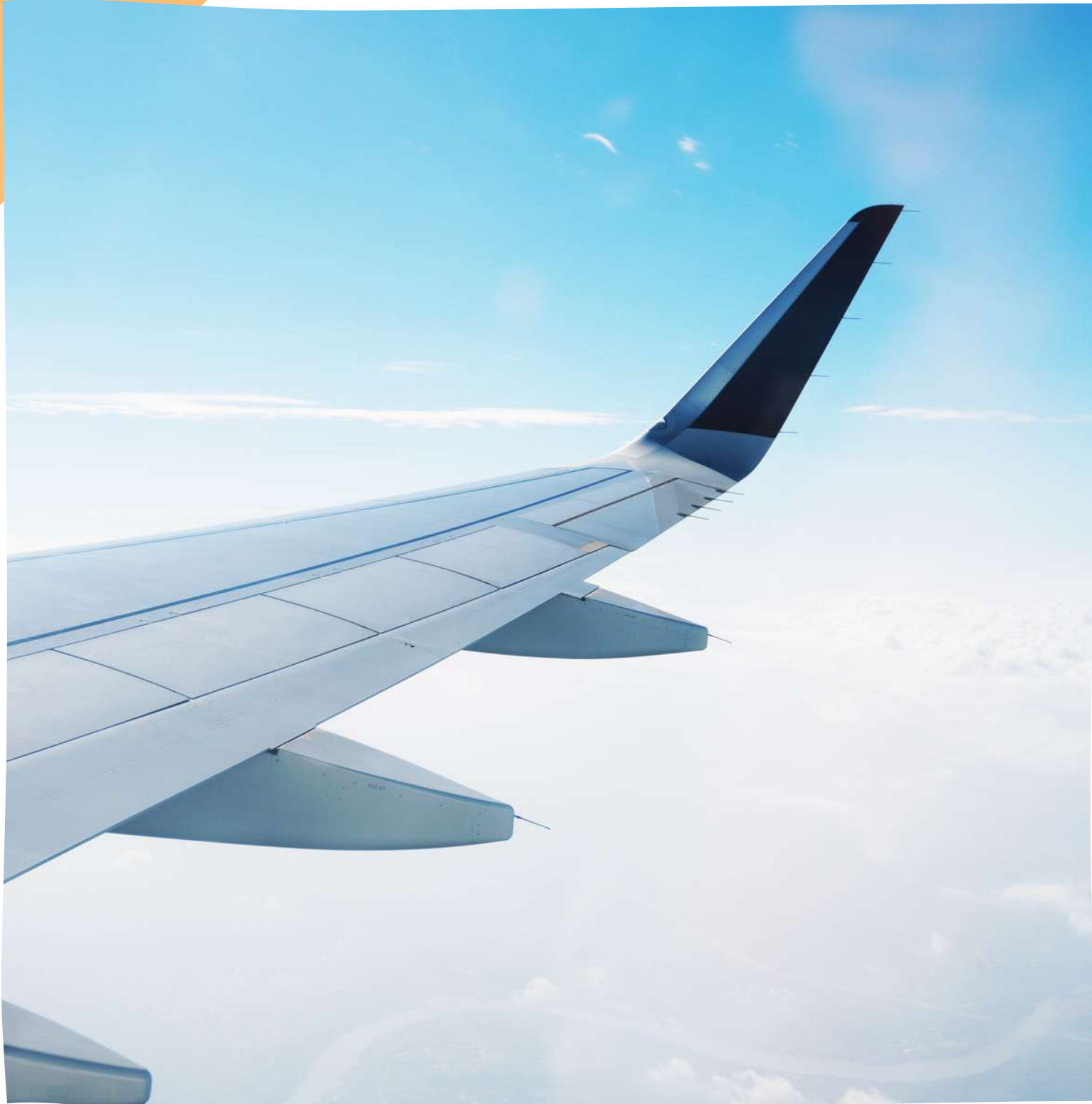
