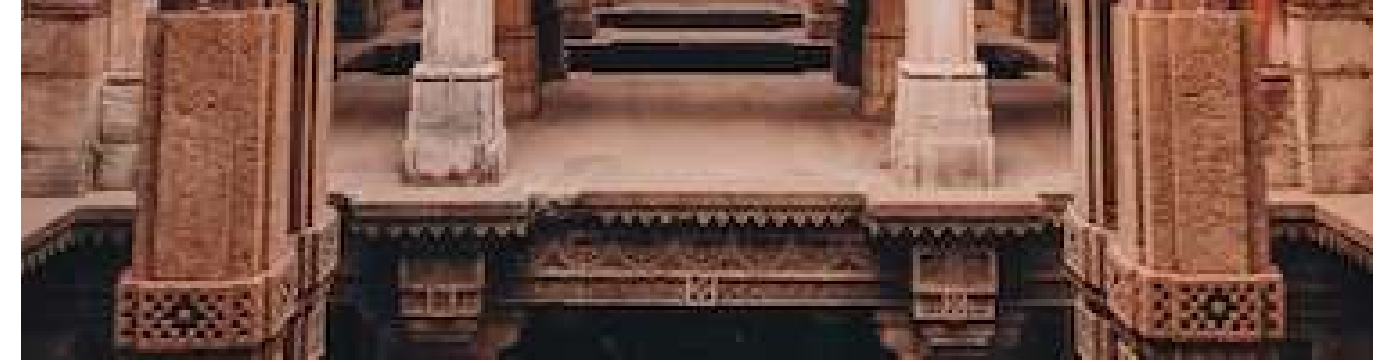


Khajuraho

A group of stunning temples with incredibly detailed carvings is nestled in the jungles of Madhya Pradesh. Between 950 and 1050 CE, the Chandela dynasty constructed the majority of the temples. Only 25 of the original 85 temples, dispersed over a four-mile region, are still standing. They formerly covered an area of little more than seven miles. The temple complex, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is split into three sections: the Western, Eastern, and Southern spheres.

Explore Khajuraho

- In the Chhatarpur district of central Madhya Pradesh sits the picturesque small village of Khajuraho.
- The beautiful Bundelkhand gneiss rock bed at Chhatarpur, where Khajuraho is situated, is thought to be the oldest rock in India.
- Named after the common date palm (khajura), Khajuraho
- Both the Jain and Hindu religions are represented in the Khajuraho temples.
- Eight kilometres separate the modest domestic airport in Khajuraho from the city centre.





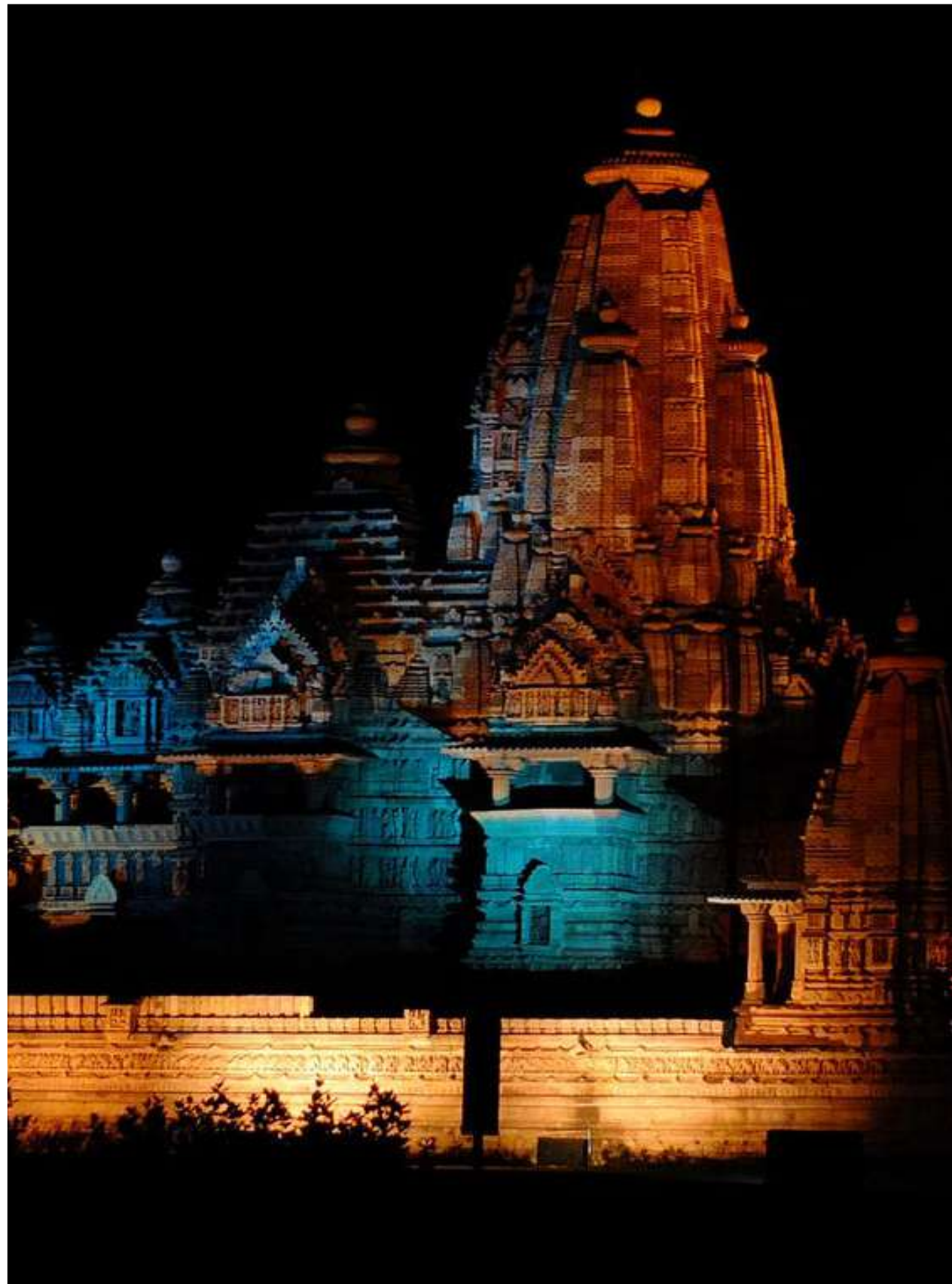
Khajuraho Temples

An ancient city called Khajuraho is renowned for its majestic temples (Mandir) and elaborate sculptures. The city, which is in Madhya Pradesh's Chattarpur district, is home to magnificent architecture and enthralling historical tales. According to historical records, there were 85 temples in the Khajuraho temple site in the 12th century, covering 20 square kilometres. Only 25 of these temples—scattered throughout a six-square-kilometer area—have endured the passage of time.

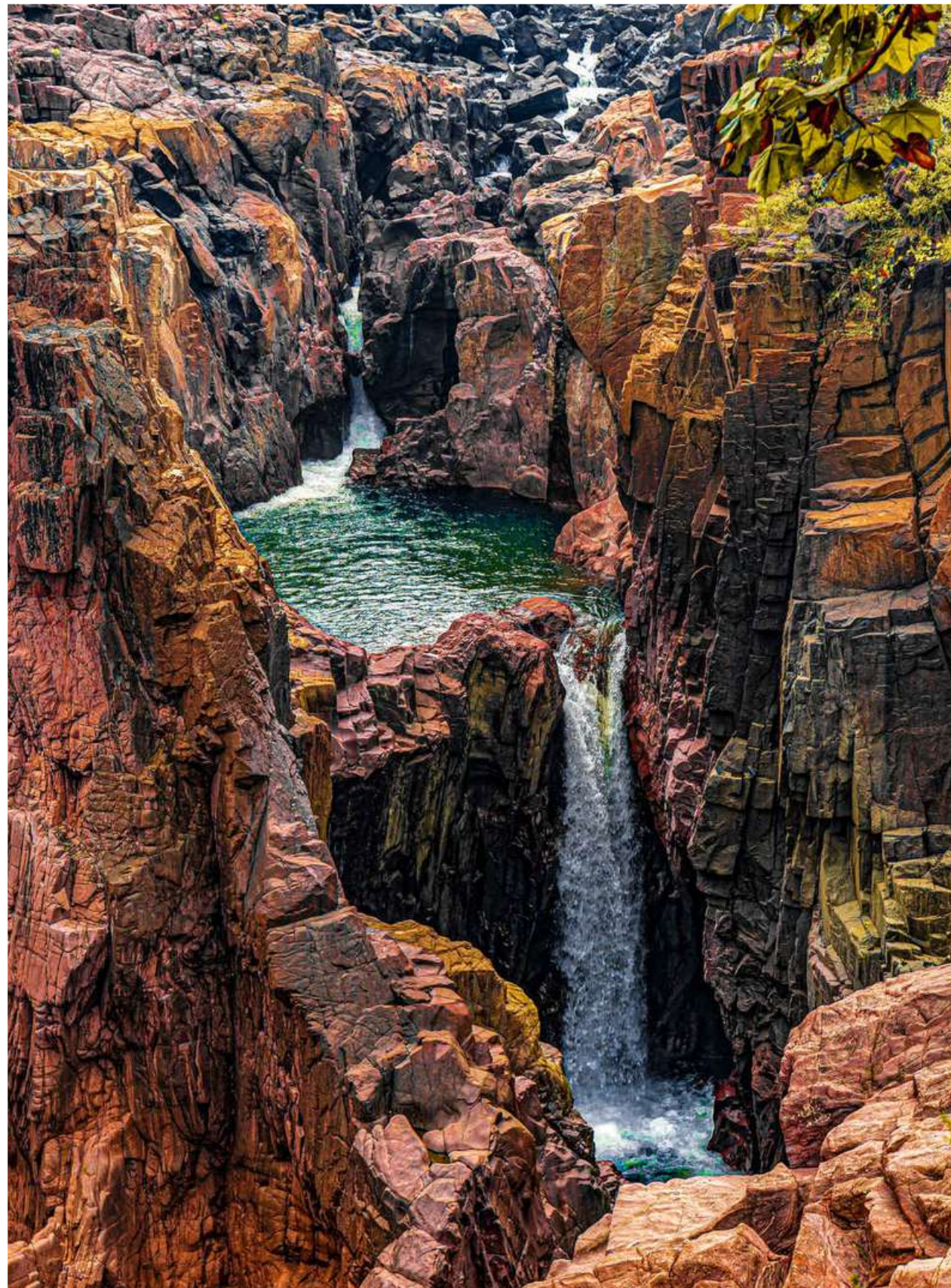


Khajuraho Light & Sound Show

The management team hosts the well-liked nightly event for tourists, the Khajuraho sound and light show. The greatest nighttime activity for travellers to learn about the myths, history, and architecture of the Khajuraho temples is this. Two rounds of organisation take place at the Khajuraho Western Group of Temples complex. The first round is conducted in English, while the second round is conducted in Hindi. It lasts for roughly an hour.

Ranesh Waterfall

Khajuraho

The Ranesh Fall is an unmanmade waterfall on the Ken River in Khajuraho, Madhya Pradesh, India. A 5 kms long and 30 m deep canyon, formed by the Ken River, is composed entirely of pink, red, and grey colours of pure crystalline granite. The canyon contains a number of waterfalls. Every year, there are larger and smaller falls. During monsoons, other seasonal falls arise. It is located at a distance of 20 kms from Khajuraho.



Jain Museum

The Jain Museum, a circular structure housed within the Jain Temples Complex, is filled with enormous statues and sculptures of Jain Tirthankaras and Yakshis. The fabled Makara Torana monsters stand on either side of the entrance gate. It is surrounded by a garden that features some beautiful sculptures and stone carvings from the Jain dynasty.

State Museum of Tribal & Folk Art

The State Museum of Tribal and Folk Art is located in Khajuraho's Chandela Cultural Complex and features rare statues, tribal artefacts, and paintings. The artefacts on display provide a look into the customs and rituals of the tribal people. Over 500 items composed of jewellery, masks, terracotta, folk art, and woodcraft are on display.

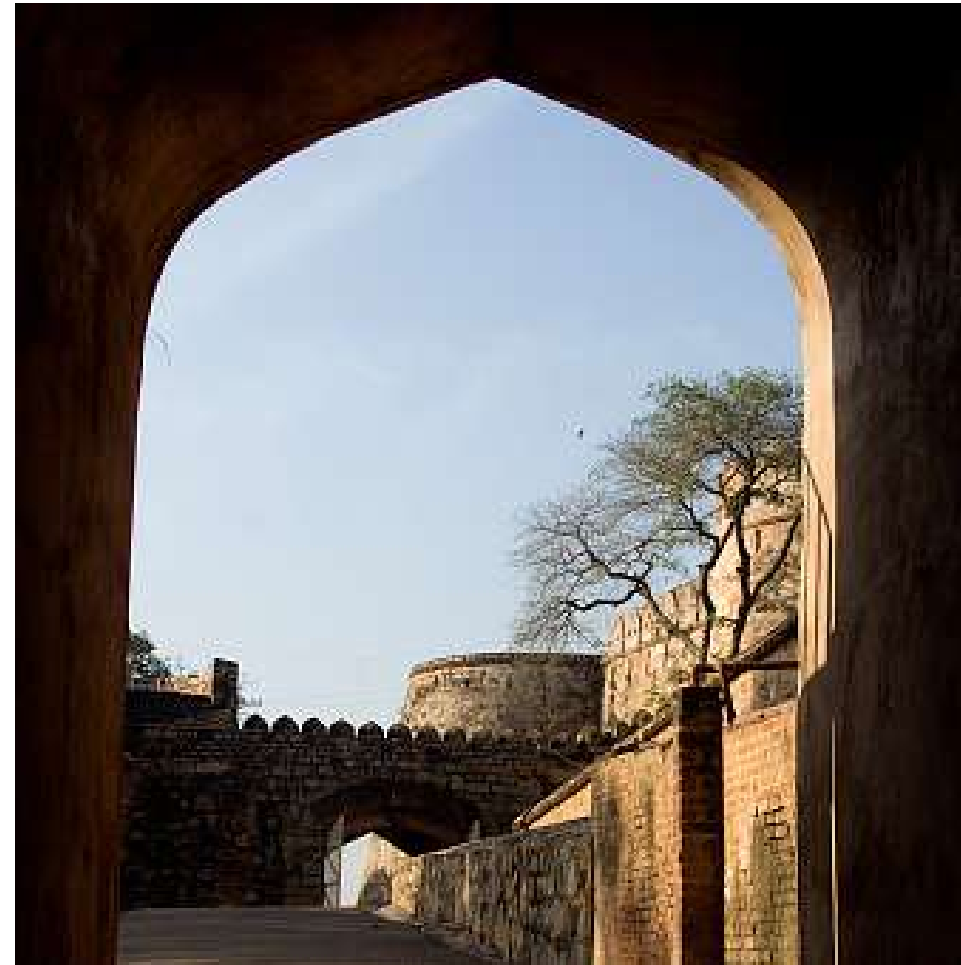


Nearby Cities
