


Kodaikanal




Explore Kodaikanal

- The summer season, which lasts from late March to early June, is the ideal time to visit Kodaikanal because of the pleasant weather.








Kodaikanal Lake

One of Tamil Nadu's most well-known tourist attractions is the Kodaikanal Lake. This manmade lake in the shape of a star is situated 2285 metres above sea level. The collector of Madurai, Sir Vere Hentry Levinge, built Kodai Lake back in 1863. After retiring, he relocated to Kodaikanal and made the decision to construct this lake on an abandoned marshy area. Currently, visitors can go boating and fishing here.


Coaker's Walk

Pillar Rocks





- Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel










