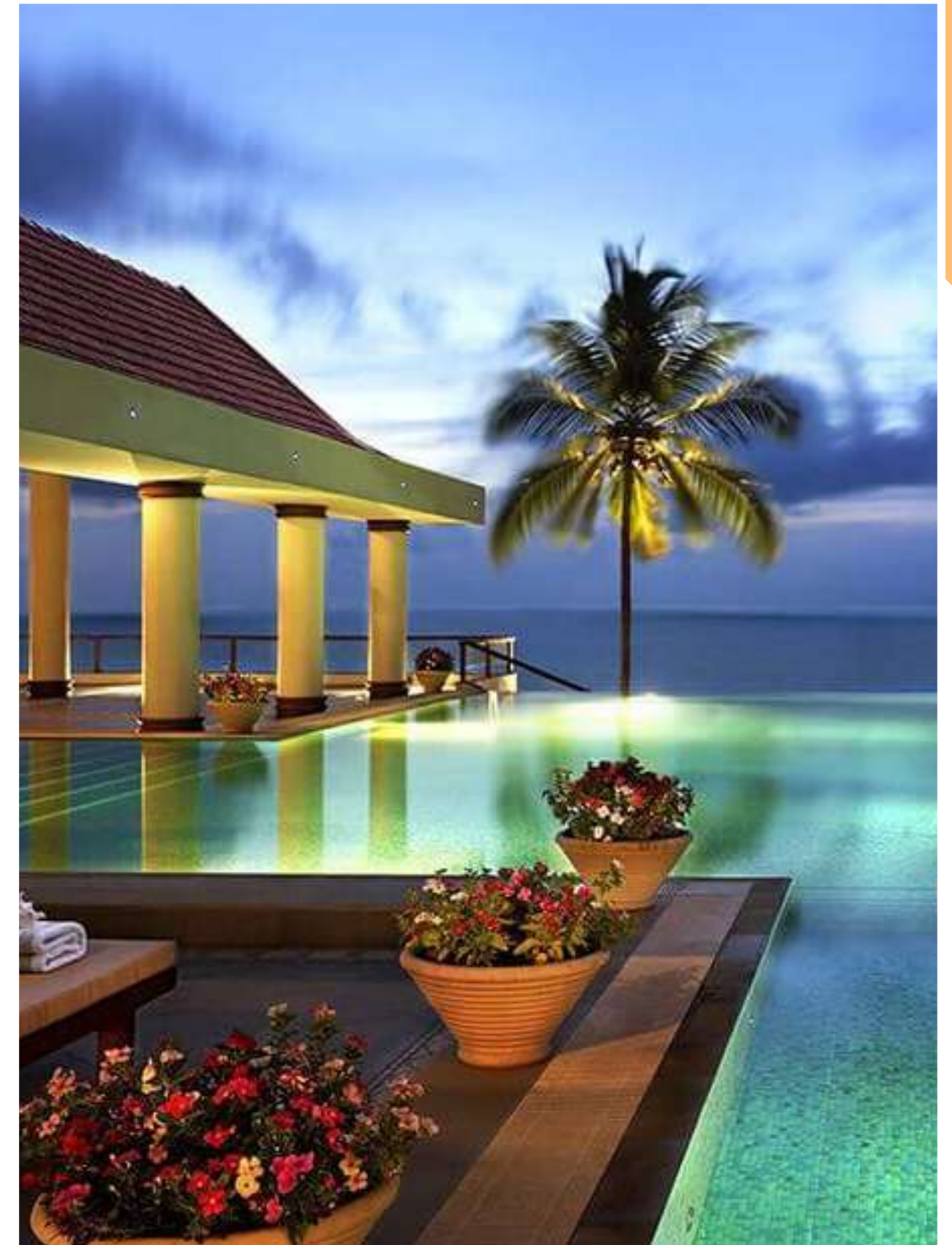

Lighthouse Beach

Shri Padmanabhaswamy Temple

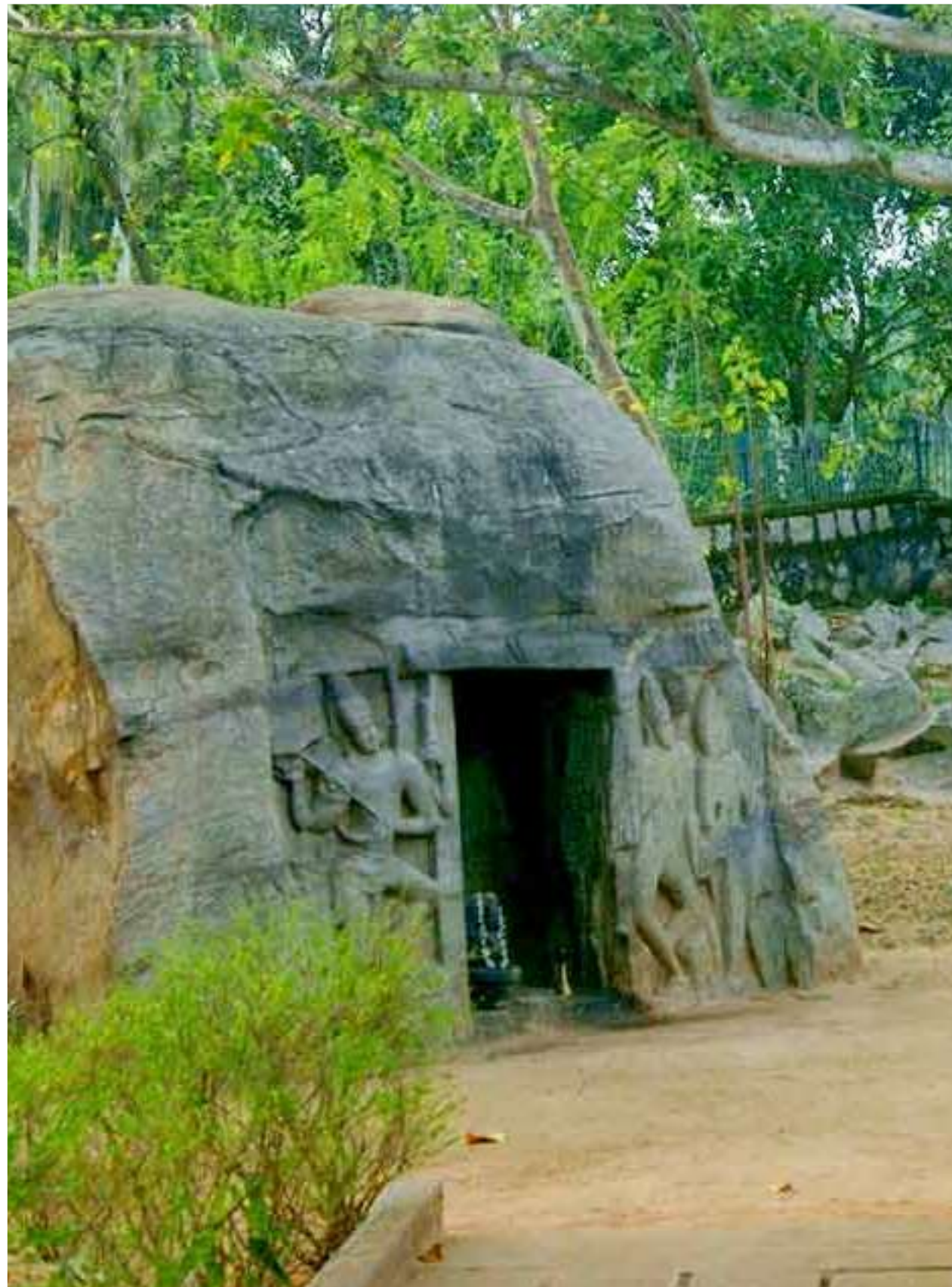
The distinctive architecture of the Shri Padmanabhaswamy Temple, one of the most popular temples in the state, must be experienced before leaving Kovalam. Lord Vishnu also goes by the name Padmanabhaswamy, and this temple is one of the 108 shrines dedicated to this Hindu deity. To access the temple, visitors must adhere to the customary dress requirement. Men must wear dhoti, while women must wear a sari or churidar. Keep in mind that only Hindus are permitted into the shrine. In Kovalam, Shri Padmanabhaswamy Temple is undoubtedly among the best places to visit.

Vizhinjam Rock Cut Cave Temple

The Vizhinjam Rock-cut cave, thought to be the smallest rock-cut shrine in southern India, dates to the 8th Century. On either side of the central cell, which features a separate sculpture of Dakshinamurthy, at Siva and Parvathi statues in progress. It is thought to be one of Kerala's first rock-cut cave temples. The Archaeological Survey of India has been in charge of this rock-cut cave as a protected monument since 1965.

Napier Museum

The magnificent Napier Museum and the Natural History Museum are located in the museum complex, near to the zoological park, in the centre of the city. It has a built in the 19th Century, t here are several historical artefacts here, including bronze I dols, vintage jewellery, a chariot pulled by a temple, and ivory carvings.

John Napier, a previous governor general of Madras, is honoured in the museum's name.

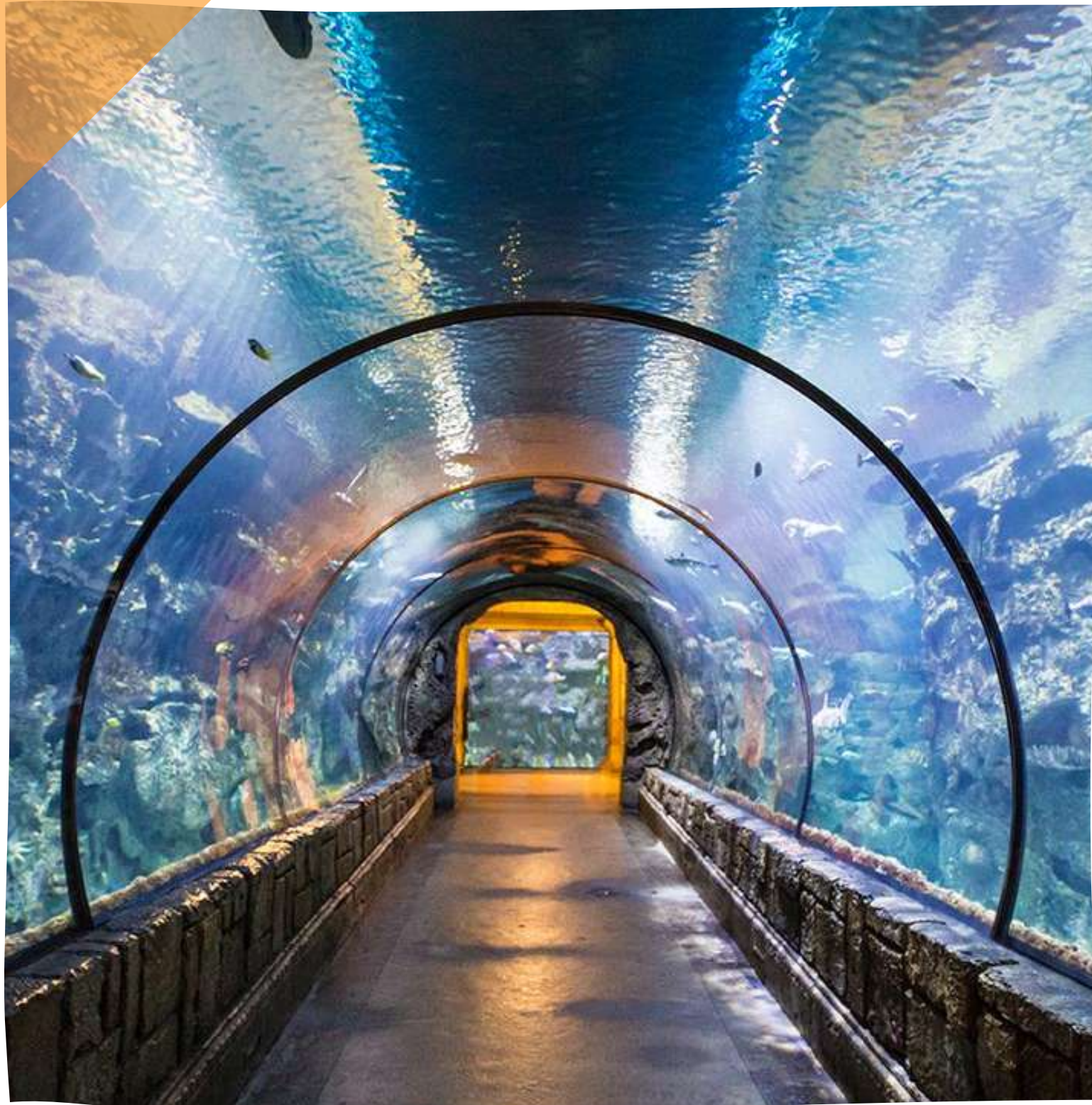
