Explore Lucknow

- Lucknow, affectionately known as the City of Nawabs, has made a name for itself with its tehzeeb (manners), rich architecture, lovely parks, mouthwatering cuisine, and much more.
- The best time of year to visit Lucknow and most of North India is from October to March.
- Janeshwar Mishra Park, which covers an area of more than 376 acres, is renowned for being Asia's largest park.
- Lucknow is referred to be the "Cctv city of India" because it has over 9000 cameras installed throughout the city.
- With a height of 220 feet, the Hussainabad clock tower is the tallest in all of India.
- Lucknow is well-known for its 400-year-old and distinctive Chickankari embroidery technique.



Bara Imambara

It is a significant place of worship for Muslims who go here annually to observe the Islamic festival of Muharram. It is also known as Asfi Imambara, after the name of the Nawab of Lucknow who ordered its construction. Bara Imambara is regarded as a wonder of engineering and a remarkable example of Mughal architecture. It is claimed to be the largest structure in the world that is not supported by beams.

Chota Imambara

The Chhota Imambara, also known as the Imambara of Hussainabad, is one of the most stunning and alluring structures in Lucknow's old city. This magnificent monument is located to the west of Bara Imambara and is truly impressive. The Chhota Imambara was once a Shia Muslim meeting hall that was constructed in 1838 by Muhammad Ali Shah, the third Nawab of Awadh. His mother and himself were intended to be buried there together in the Imambara.

Rumi Darwaza

In Lucknow's ancient city, the renowned Rumi Darwaza is a spectacular doorway that rises sixty feet above the ground. It is a piece of historic Awadhi architecture located between the Bara Imambara and the Chota Imambara. It was created by Nawab Asaf-ud-Daula and is also referred to as the Turkish Gate because it was modelled after Turkey's Bab-i-Humayun entryway. Rumi Darwaza, located in the centre of Lucknow, towers over the busy daily bustle of Lajpatnagar like a seasoned watchman who has witnessed the rise and fall of the city.

Ambedkar Memorial Park

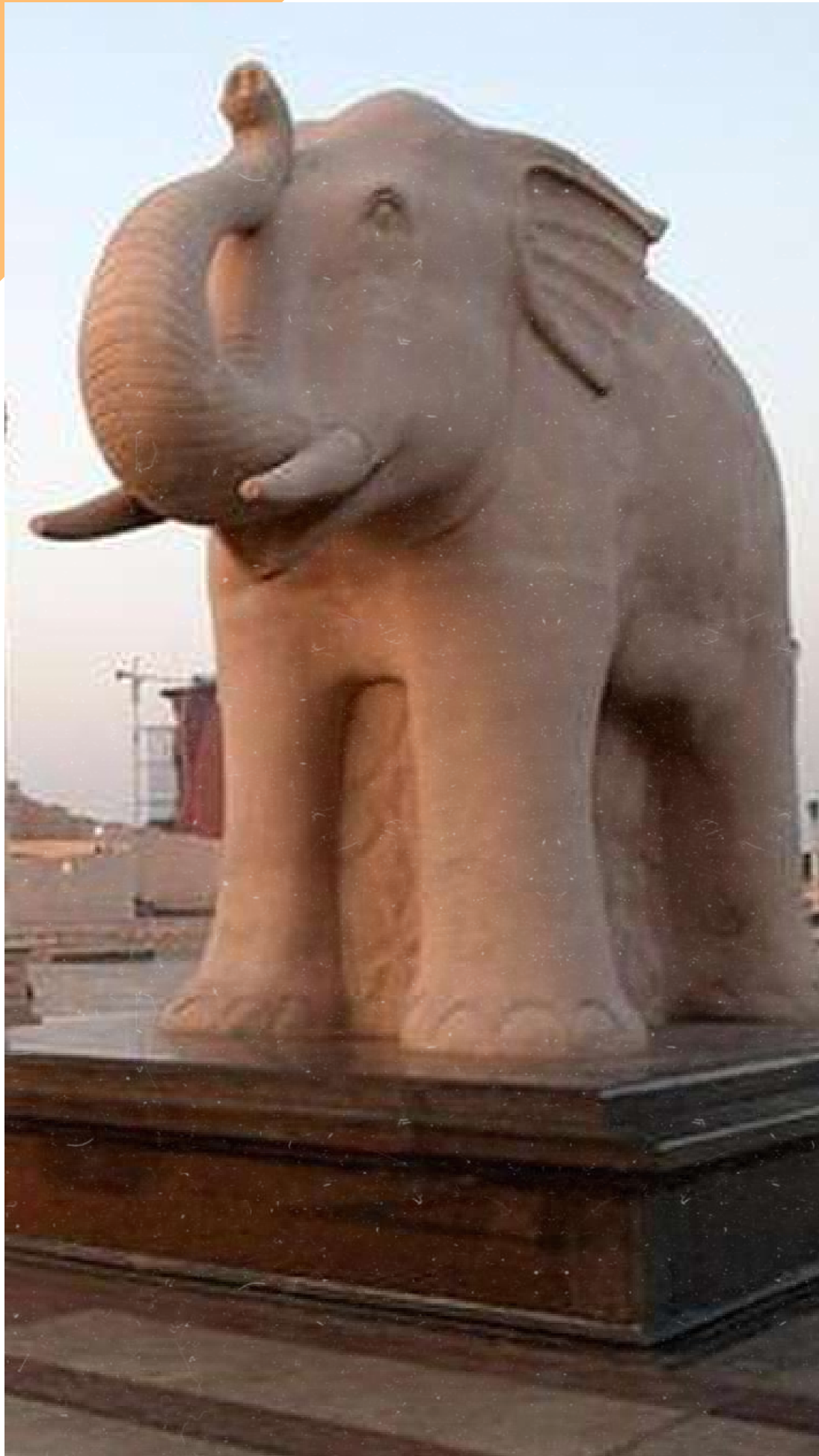

It was built by the state government, which was presided over by CM Mayawati. This public park, which was created in honour of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar and other freedom warriors. The park is home to numerous statues and buildings with significant historical significance despite its lack of greenery.
