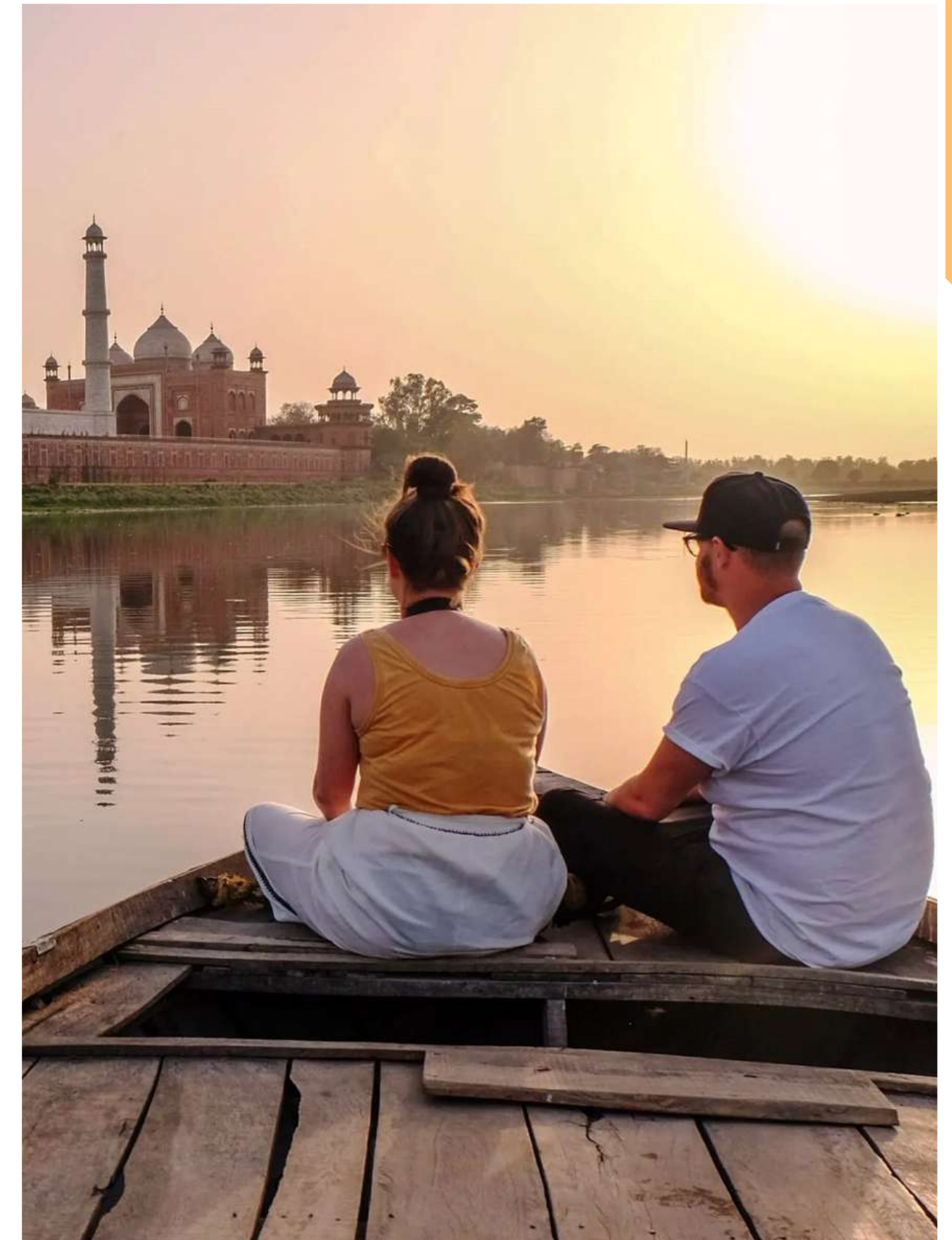

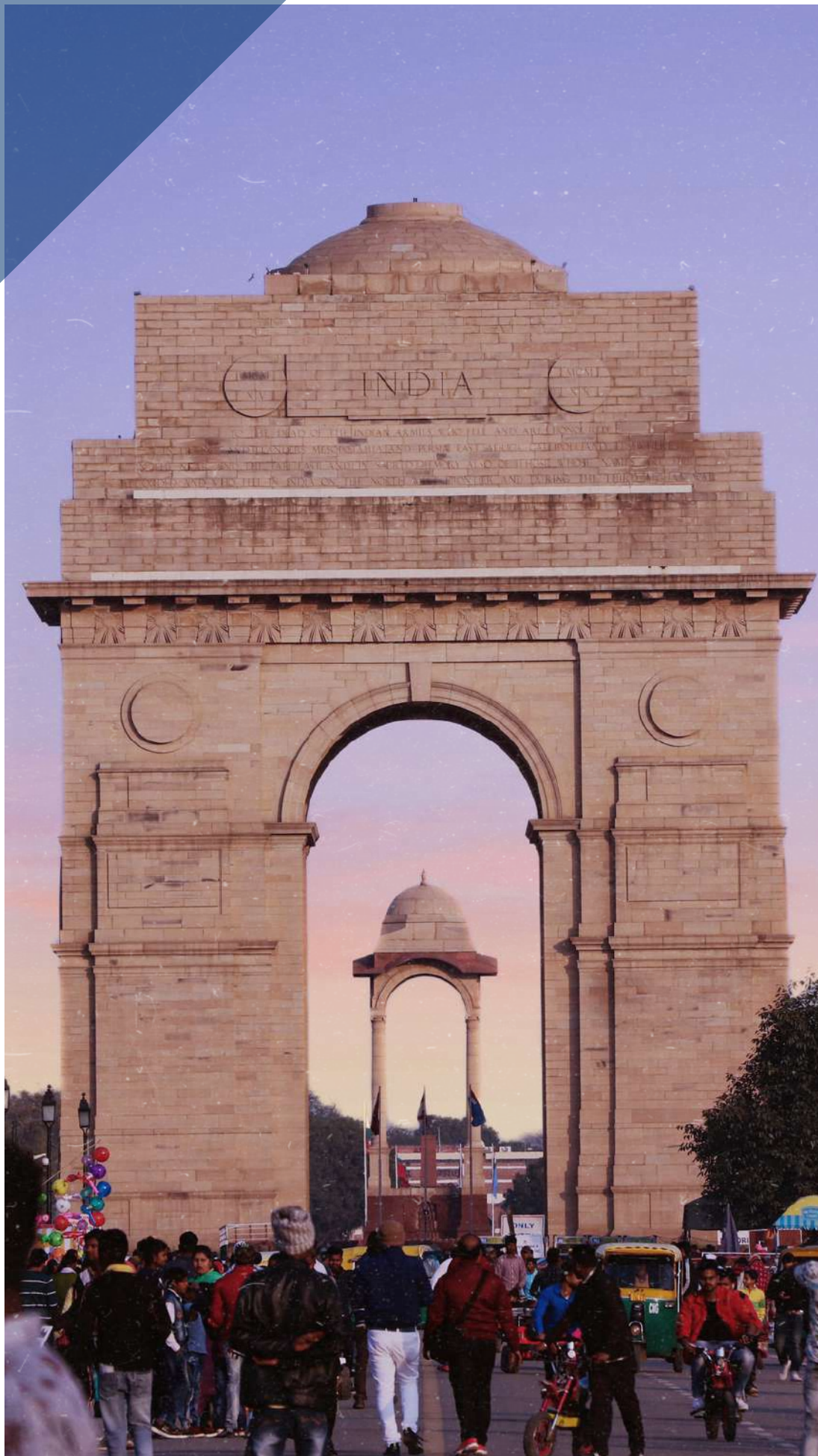

India Gate

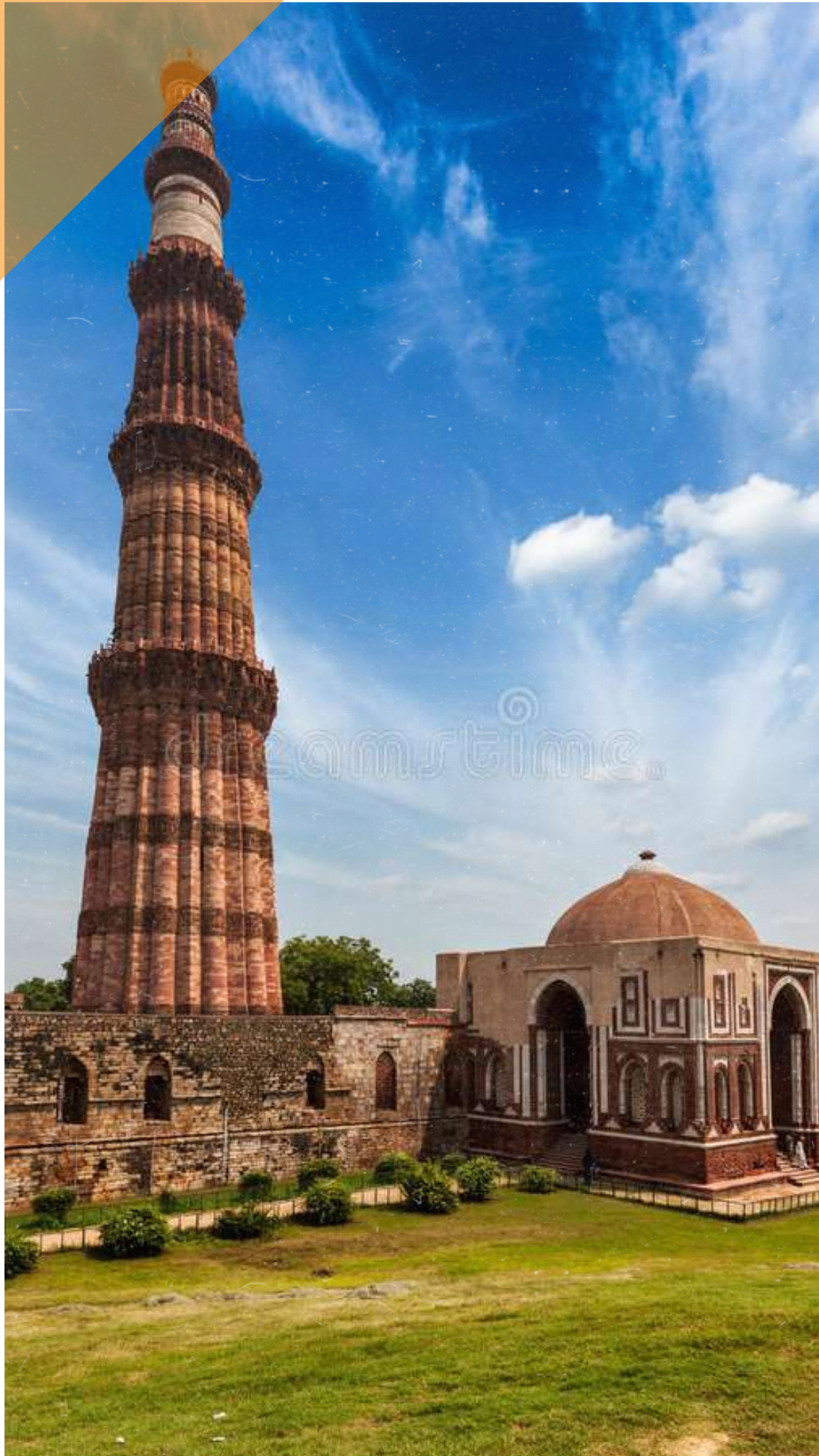
This sombre memorial was erected in honour of the 90,000 Indian troops who lost their lives fighting in World War I. It was formerly known as the All India War Memorial and was constructed in 1931 under Lutyens' design. The walls of the arc of the gate are etched with the names of the troops. An eternal light was set here later in 1971 in honour of the unidentified troops who lost their lives in the Indo-Pakistan War of 1971.

Qutub Minar

Qutbuddin Aibak constructed the Qutub Minar, the tallest stone structure in India (1192). It was constructed in honour of Ghoris triumph over the Rajputs. The Minar is a five-story structure that rises 72.5 metres. During the lifetime of Qutbuddin, the first floor of the Qutb Minar was finished. Iltumush, his son-in-law and successor, added the next three stories. Qutb Minar is a successful testament to architecture since it contains the renowned Iron Pillar, which has stood there for millennia without rusting.

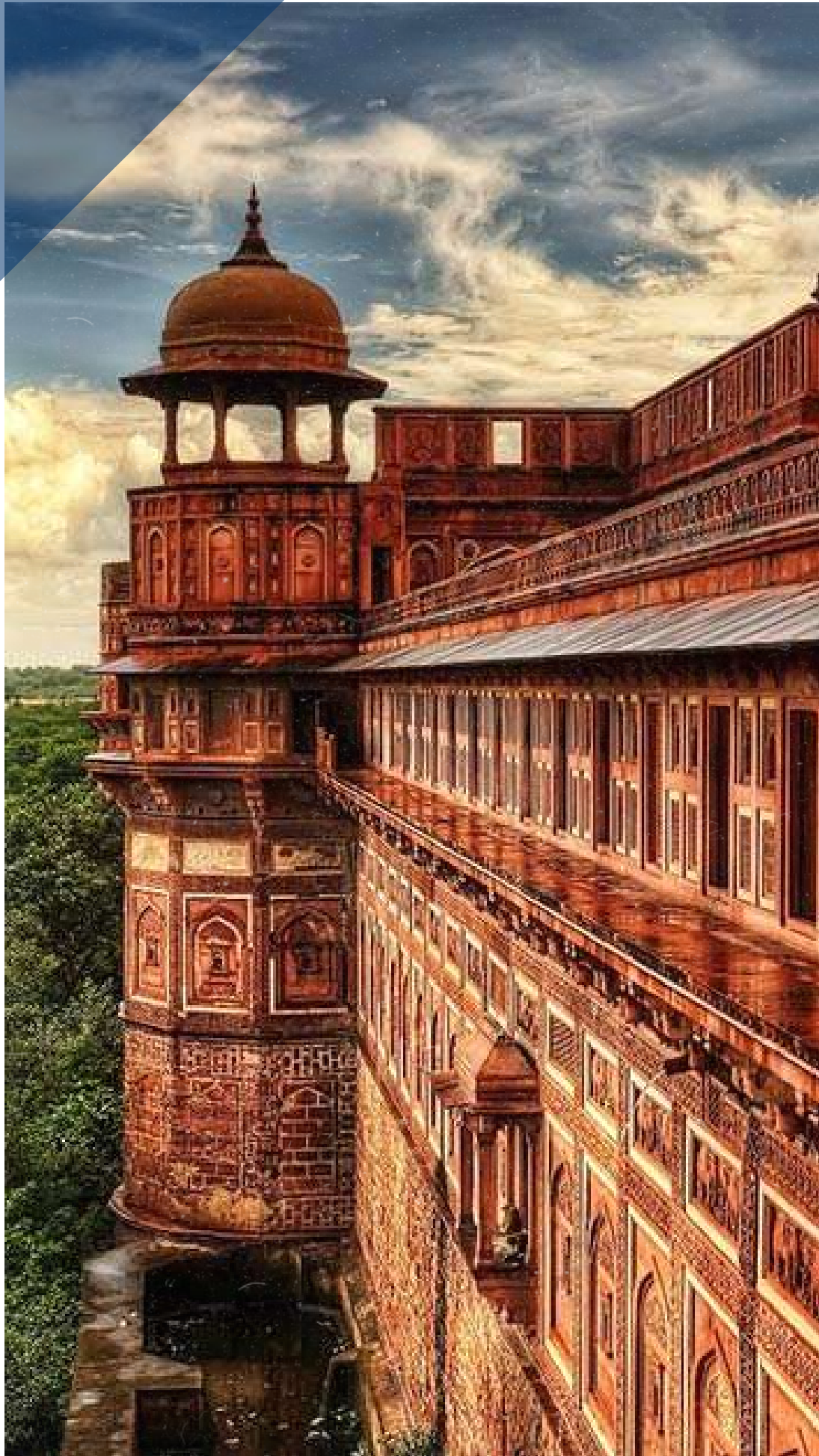

Red Fort Complex

The Red Fort Complex was constructed to serve as the palace fort of Shahjahanabad, the fifth Mughal Emperor of India, Shah Jahan's new capital. It is called the Red Fort Complex because of the large red sandstone walls that surround it. This fort is next to the Salimgarh, an older fort that Islam Shah Suri constructed in 1546. Later structures and gardens in Rajasthan, Delhi, Agra, and other places were greatly affected by the Red Fort's avant-garde planning and architectural style, including the garden design.

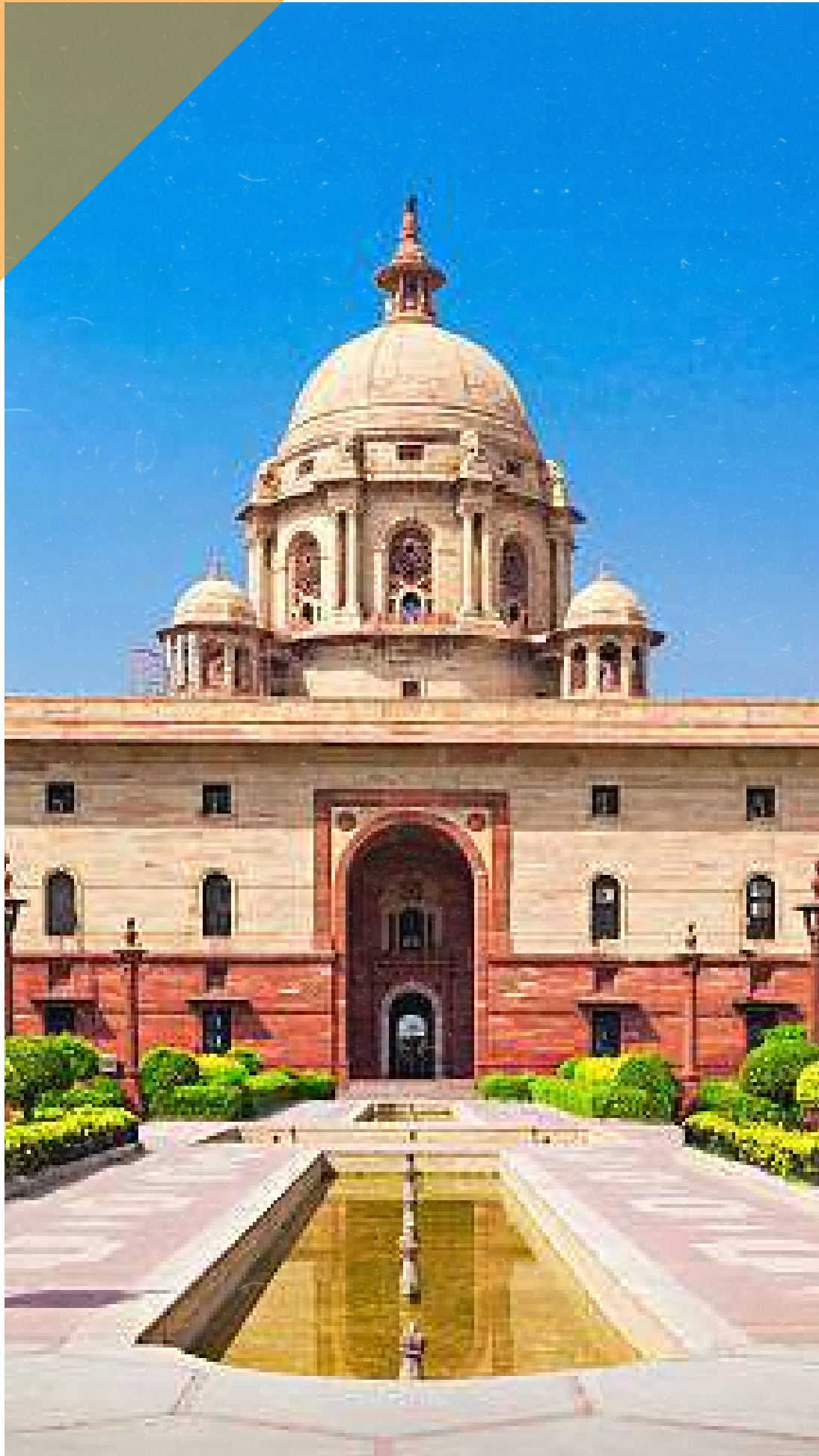

Rashtrapati Bhavan

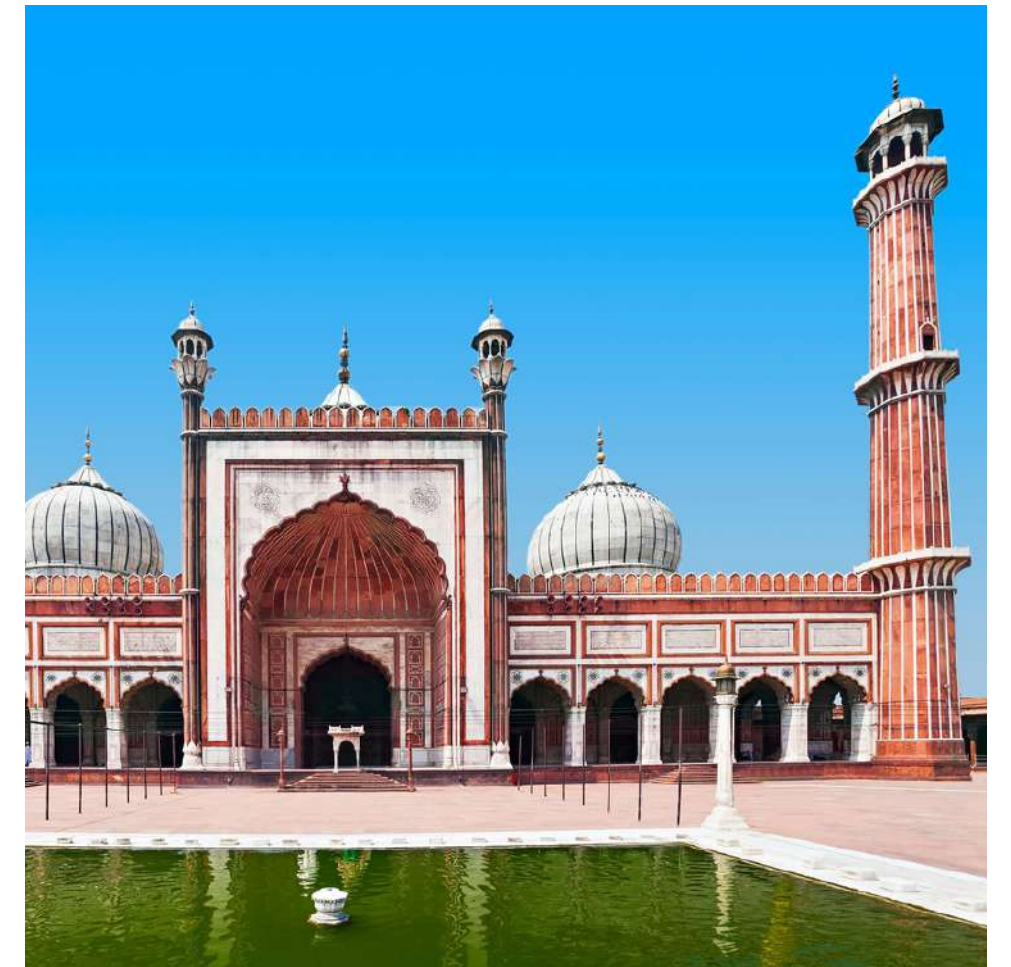

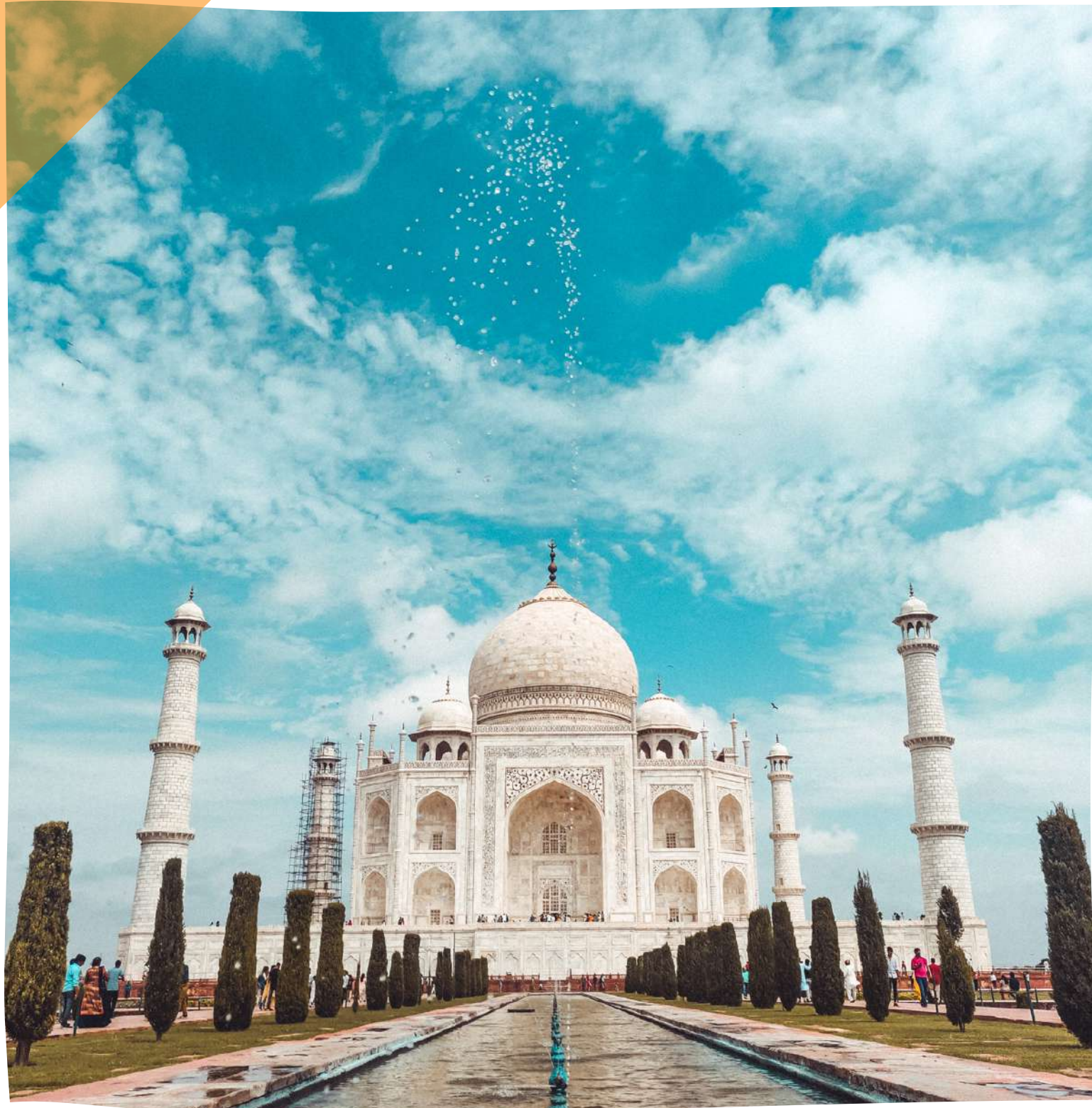
