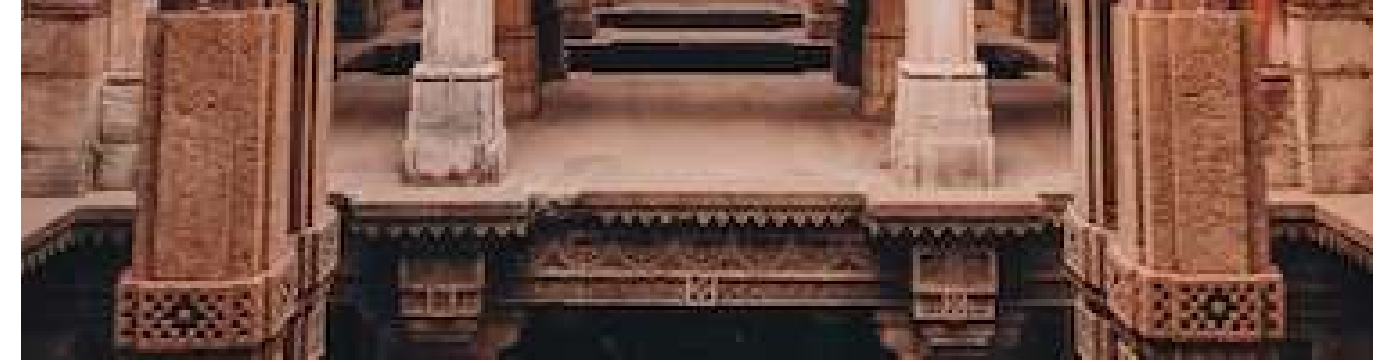


Odisha

- Bhubaneswar is home to Odisha's main airport.

Jagannath Temple

The Jagannath Temple, often known as the pride of India, was constructed in the 11th century by King Indradyumna and is situated in the holy town of Puri. Lord Jagannath, who is a manifestation of Lord Vishnu, resides in this magnificent temple. It is regarded as the most important Hindu pilgrimage destination and is a part of the famous Char Dham Yatra together with Badrinath, Dwarka, and Rameshwaram. The complex's numerous smaller temples will give you the impression that you have reached God's actual house.

Konark Sun Temple



One of the top tourist destinations in Odisha is the UNESCO World Heritage site Konark Sun Temple, which is located on the northeastern edge of Puri. It was constructed in the shape of a massive rath, or chariot, of the Sun God, and shows a team of seven horses pulling the chariot. On three distinct sides of the temple, which receive the Sun God's direct rays in the morning, afternoon, and evening, are three deities dedicated to him. The temple complex also houses a special museum of archaeology.

Chilika Lake



The largest internal saltwater lake in Asia, Chilika Lake, is a haven for wildlife and nature enthusiasts. A few small islands dot the pear-shaped lake, which is surrounded by salt pans and fishery. The Chilika Lake also has one of the most hospitable ecosystems in the entire world, thus a variety of plants and animals can be seen here. The lake also takes pride in being one of just two places on earth where it is possible to see the critically endangered Irrawaddy dolphins.

Golden Beach, Puri



Golden Beach, which is 20 kilometers from Puri, is a spotless, tranquil beach away from the hustle and bustle of the city. On a brief detour from the highway heading to Konark, you can find this magnificent beach uncrowded by frequent pilgrims. The beach is undeveloped and barren, boasting a serene atmosphere with only the sound of the waves smashing nearby.

Lingaraj Temple



The Lingaraj Temple, the oldest temple in the city of Bhubaneswar, is also the largest one there. The temple, as its name suggests, is dedicated to Lord Shiva and was constructed in the seventh century by King Jajati Keshari. It is greatly venerated since it is thought that the Linga, a manifestation of Lord Shiva, here spontaneously appeared. It measures roughly 8 feet in circumference and rises to a huge height of 8 inches above floor level. It is situated in the historic district of Bhubaneswar Town and is conveniently accessible by public transportation.

Nandankanan Zoological Park

The first zoo in India with a white tiger safari is Nandankanan. It offers a distinctive setting where the animals walk free in the open forest while the visitors are confined to a car. The visitors are taken directly into the pride of lions on the lion safari after a twenty-minute trip in a specially protected vehicle through winding roads that span the natural forest. Additionally, tourists can use the safari bus service to get a close-up view of sloth bears in their natural environment.

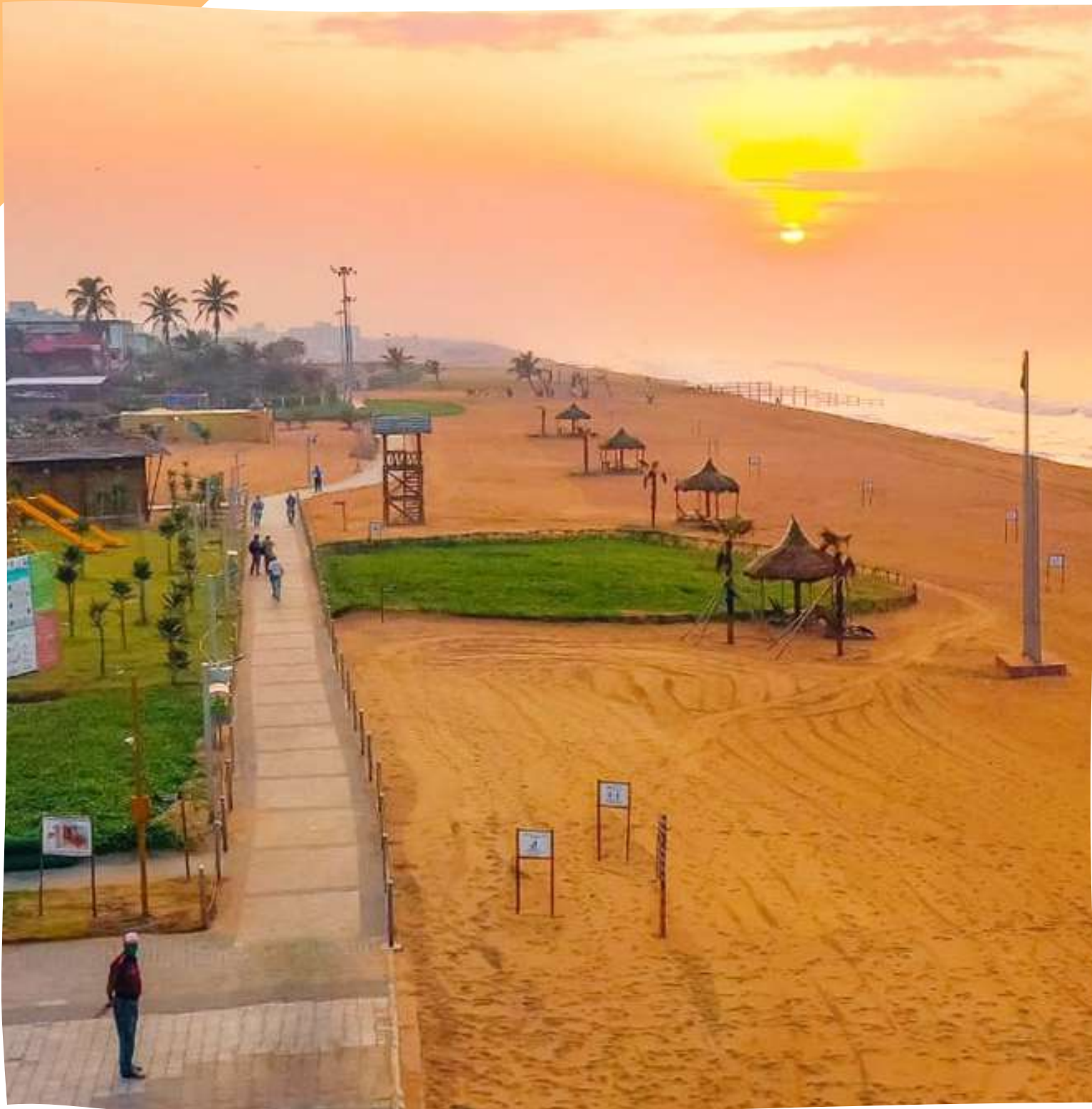

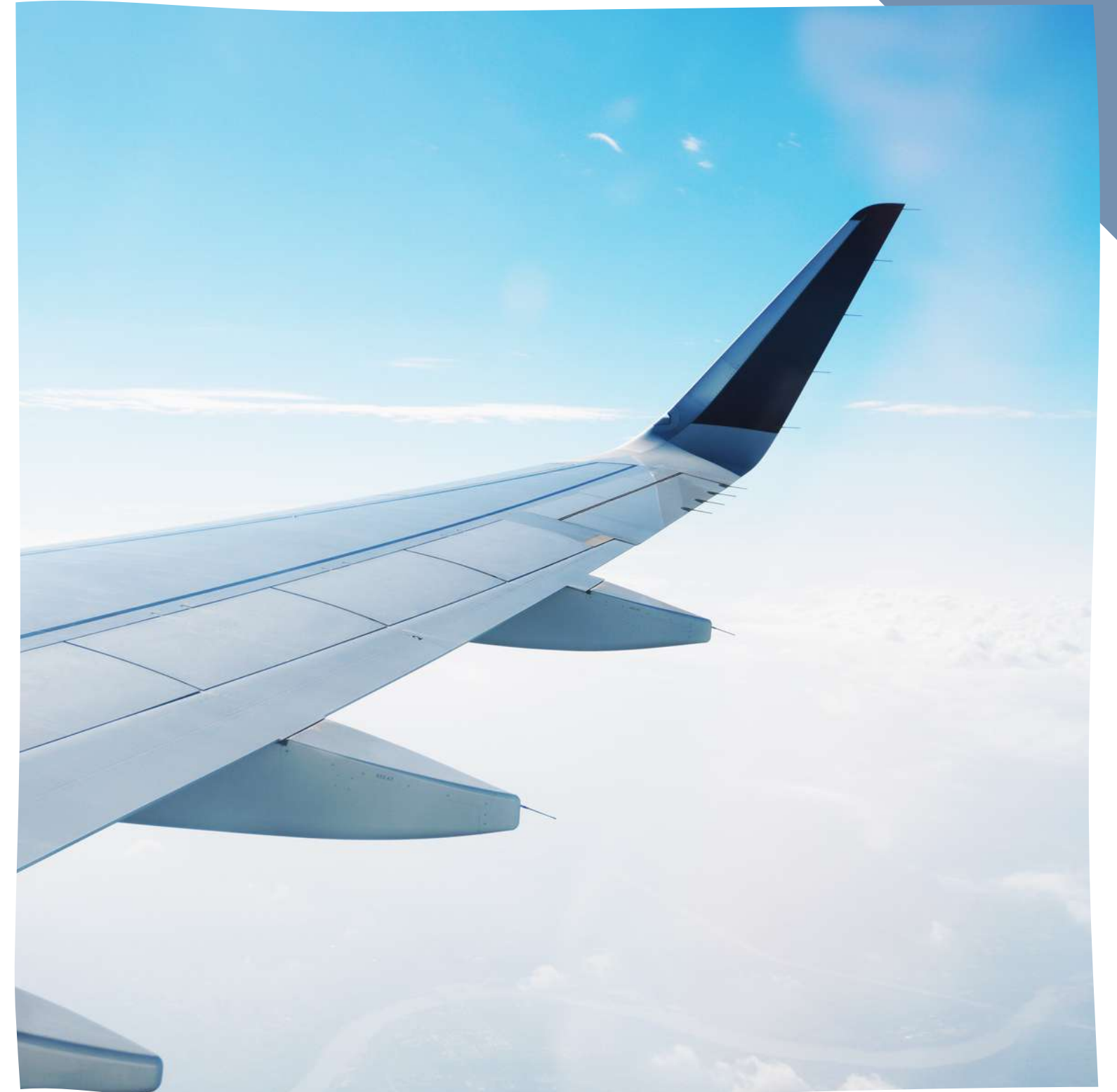
