


# Visakhapatnam



### Submarine Museum

INS The Indian Navy's Kursura (S20), a diesel-electric submarine of the Kalvari class. She was the fifth submarine for India. After 31 years of service, Kursura was decommissioned on February 27, 2001, having been put into service on December 18, 1969. She took part in the 1971 Indo-Pakistani War. After being decommissioned, the vessel was hauled to RK Beach in Visakhapatnam, where it was converted into a museum ship, the region's first submarine museum.



### Kailasa Giri


A stunning hilltop park set at a height of 360 feet, Kailash Giri is found amid the picturesque region of Vizag. The park, which spans more than 100 acres of verdant land, is positioned on a hilltop and gives stunning panoramic views of the neighborhood and the beach below. The beautiful 40-foot-tall white-painted statues of Shiva and Parvati are the site's main attraction.

### Dolphin's Nose

This 174-meter-high granite headland, which resembles a dolphin's nose, is located south of Vizag. It has a really intriguing appearance because the snout appears to be sticking out toward the Bay of Bengal. Also located close by is a well-known, powerful lighthouse that is very helpful to shippers and whose light beam can be seen up to 64 kilometers out at sea. Additionally, there is a hill nearby known as Dolphin Hill, which is a restricted military residential enclave.




### Araku Valley

A hill station called Araku Valley is located 120 kilometers west of Vizag. This location is frequently referred to as the Andhra Ooty. It is a valley in the Eastern Ghats which numerous tribes call home. Bauxite is mined in the Araku Valley's Anantagiri and Sunkarimetta Reserved Forests, which are home to a diverse range of wildlife. One of the highest peaks in Andhra Pradesh is Galikonda Hill, which rises to a height of 5,000 feet (1,500 m).

### Borra Caves

In the Ananthagiri hills of the Araku Valley are the Borra Caves, also known as Borra Guhalu. At an elevation of around 705 m (2,313 ft), the caves, which are among the biggest in the nation, prominently display a variety of speleothems with sizes that range between stalactites and stalagmites with odd shapes. The caves, which extend to a depth of 80 meters (260 feet), are primarily karstic limestone constructions and are regarded as India's deepest caves.



### Simhachalam Temple

The Simhachalam temple, a lavish shrine that is located in Vishakhapatnam, is regarded as one of the most significant temples in the region. The structure, which is dedicated to Lord Narasimha, a manifestation of Vishnu, is located 800 meters above sea level. It is possible to see Simhachalam Temple from a distance because of its intricate stone carvings and design. Shri Varaha Lakshmi Narasimha Swami, a hybrid of Lord Vishnu's third and fourth incarnations, can only be found in this one temple in the nation.
